

Age Sex Breakdown by Zone

The family counting exercise collects the total declared size of each family, as well as the total size of the family physically verified by the enumerator during the count. Based on the total declared size of the family, the data is collected on the number of individuals within the family as per the age-sex cohort broken down below. As of 30 October, 54% of the total population counted are children (under 18 years old), and specifically 19% are under the age of 5 years old. While 52% of the total population counted are women and girls, there are more adult females aged 18 years and above (25%) compared to adult males (21%). Among the children under 18 years old, there does not seem to be a big discrepancy by sex, with 51% of children being boys and 49% of children being girls.

Population Density by Zone

Using GIS technology, polygons of the ISCG Zones were established. The GPS coordinates of each family counted during the exercise were then mapped into the polygons, in order to determine the total number of families and persons counted within each ISCG Zone. Based on satellite imagery and field mapping conducted by Site Planning colleagues, the total useable area (sqm) was also calculated. Therefore although there seem to be empty pockets in Zones LL, KK and II, these are in fact paddy field areas, where refugees have not settled. These calculations indicate that the areas of highest density per useable sqm of area per person are located in Zones MM, BB, CC, Balukhali makeshift and Kutupalong Refugee Camp, which is in line with the observations collected by the field. Generally, with the exception of Balukhali makeshift, the zones in the Balukhali extension generally have a higher degree of useable area (sqm) per person.

Arrival Date Breakdown by Zone

The Rohingya refugee population can largely be broken down into five different caseloads - (i) the registered refugee population that have been living in Bangladesh for over twenty years, (ii) the unregistered refugee population that arrived prior to Oct 2016, (iii) refugees who arrived during the October 2016 influx, (iv) refugees who arrived during the 25 August influx and (v) those who continue to arrive since 17 October 2017. The majority of Rohingya refugees currently residing in Ukhia region, Cox's Bazaar are all new arrivals as a result of the August 2017 violence in Rakhine state (79%), the majority of whom are settled mostly in Kutupalong makeshift and the larger KTP extension. further 64,386 individuals arrived as a result of the October 2016 influx, the majority of whom are also settled mostly in Kutupalong makeshift or its extension. Although the majority of the newest arrivals from October 2017 are still settling around the KTP extension, there is a significant number (803 persons) who have settled in Zone SS, presumably due to the fact that the KTP extension have become incredibly dense.

Place of Origin Breakdown by Township

98.8% of all Rohingya refugees who arrived in Bangladesh after August 2017 are from Northern Rakhine State, 70% of whom all fled from Maungdaw township, 22% from Buthidaung township and 8% from Rathedaung township. A very small percentage of 0.74% of new arrivals also fled from Southern Rakhine State, specifically Kyaupkyu township. Further, 0.45% of the new arrivals also fled from Central Rakhine State, predominantly Sitwe township. Despite a lack of targeted violence in Central and Southern Rakhine state, 50% of those who fled from Central and Southern Rakhine state fled before the 25 August 2017 violence. The remaining 50% who arrived after 25 August 2017 may have been accompanying family members or relatives in Northern Rakhine State.

Assistance Breakdown by Zone

The figures related to assistance received is based on the refugee's own declaration, and it does not differentiate the entity or agency who provided the assistance. It does not include materials that were bought or procured directly by the refugees themselves. Food refers to rice, oil, sugar or high energy biscuits; shelter material refers to plastic sheeting, shelter kit or bamboo; basic household materials refers to cooking pots, blankets or utensils; sanitary materials refers to soap, water cans, underwear, diapers, bedpans or hygiene kits; and medicine refers to vaccine, treatments or ORS sachets.

The majority of the population (96%) have indicated that they received some form of assistance since arrival in Bangladesh. 77% indicated they have received food assistance and 71% received shelter material, however only 47% claimed to have received sanitary materials and 49% claimed to receive medicine. Only 29% claimed to have receive basic household items. A large

proportion of families in Zones AA (48%) and BB (57%) claim they have not received basic household items, and 49% of families in Zone GG and 42% of families in Zone HH claim they have not received shelter assistance.

Number of Deaths since Arrival by Zone

1% of the families counted indicated that they have had at least one death in the family since arrival in Bangladesh, with a large majority (437 families) reporting deaths while settled in the Kutupalong makeshift. While less than 1% of families living in other zones indicated they have had a family member pass away since arriving in Bangladesh, 4% of families settled in Kutupalong makeshift have had a close family member pass away since arrival.

Vulnerability Breakdown by Zone

Identification of specific needs within the refugee population requires specialized training and expertise. Given limited time, the family counting enumerators were only trained to identify physical and easily identifiable vulnerabilities. The figures below represent the total number of families with at least one specific need within the family. One family may contain more than one type of specific need. The number of persons per vulnerability type, represent the total number of individuals living in a family containing that specific need. For example, 2,129 families were identified as containing a separated child within the family, which means there is a minimum of 2,129 separate children living in the KTP expansion. However, the figure of 7,074 persons represents the total number of individuals living in a family with a separated child, it does not represent the total number of separated children.

Figures from the family counting indicate that one in three families are living with a person with a specific need. The most prevalent vulnerability identified, with 14% of the total number of families counted, compose of single females or single female headed households. This corresponds to statistics that indicate that women constitute the majority of the population. Single females also have less access to services and facilities and are at greater risk of exploitation. In addition to this, 5% of the total population have been identified with a serious medical condition and 4% respectively have been identified as child-headed households, older persons ta risk or having a visible, physical/mental disability. Particularly concerning data also indicate that 14,576 children are currently living in a child-headed household, all of which have been identified as urgent cases in need of follow-up. Of the total number of families identified with specific needs, 63% have been flagged as urgent.
