
# Indicator 5.2.2: # of boys & girls accessing CP & focused PSS






# Indicator 5.2.3: # of boys & girls assisted through CP case management services

# **Beneficiaries per Vulnerability**







# Beneficiaries per Risk Level






### Indicator 5.3.3: # of caregivers accessing CP prevention (caregivers' programs)




# Indicator 5.3.4: # of girls & boys reached on key CP issues





# Indicator 5.3.5: # of caregivers reached on key CP issues.
