General Information

The Rubber Plantation Transit Center (TC) in Kutupalong was established to temporarily receive newly arrived vulnerable refugees in urgent need of life-saving assistance pending their relocation to a site.

Established: 18 October 2017

Capacity: 1,200 refugees / 250 families
(max capacity = 1,500 persons)

Area: 47,000 m² / 11.7 acres
