**General Information**

The Rubber Plantation Transit Center (TC) in Kutupalong was established to temporarily receive newly arrived vulnerable refugees in urgent need of life-saving assistance pending their relocation to a site.

**Established:** 18 October 2017

**Capacity:** 1,200 refugees / 250 families (max capacity = 1,500 persons)

**Area:** 47,000 m<sup>2</sup> / 11.7 acres
