




Number of UAC placed in Reception and Identification Centers/Protective Custody

Number of UAC on the waiting list by location (Safe spaces, Police Stations, RICs, Temporary accommodation sites) as of 30 November 2017



UAC Shelters (transit and long-term)

- Current: 51 UAC shelters with total 1,130 places. (increased from 423 places in March 2016)

- Planned: 2 new shelters with total 30 new places

Safe Zones* (short-term)


- Current: 9 Safe Zones for UAC with total 270 places.

- Planned: 1 new Safe Zone with total 30 new places

*Safe Zones are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their best interests.






