

IRAQ - Camps Intentions Survey Round 2: Camps in Erbil, Dahuk, Sulaymaniyah and Diyala, January 2018

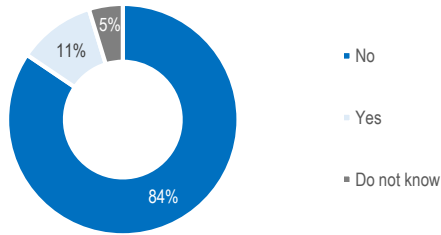

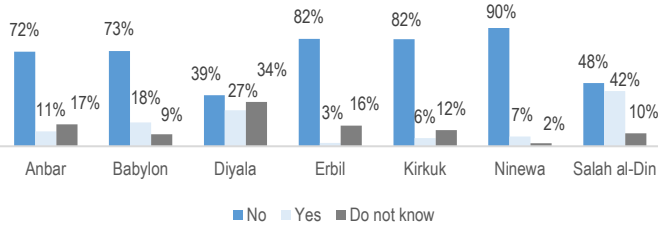
This Intentions Survey was carried out by REACH in partnership with the CCCM Cluster in **28 camps across Erbil, Dahuk, Sulaymaniyah and Diyala governorates** hosting a total of **40,114 households (211,259 individuals)**. The survey was administered to **2,609 households**, corresponding to **19,404 individuals** through a random sample¹ between 12 December 2017 and 14 January 2018.

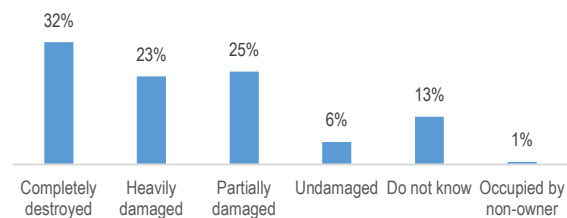
Are you currently planning on returning to your area of origin?



Are you currently planning on returning to your area of origin (AoO)? By governorate of origin

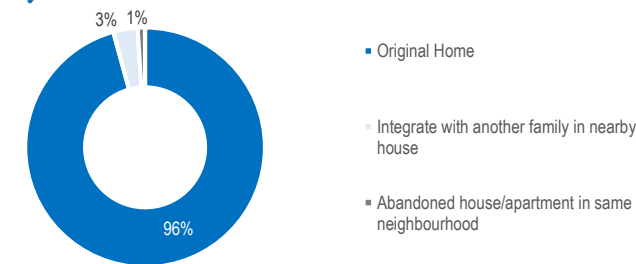


What is the condition of your house in your area of origin?

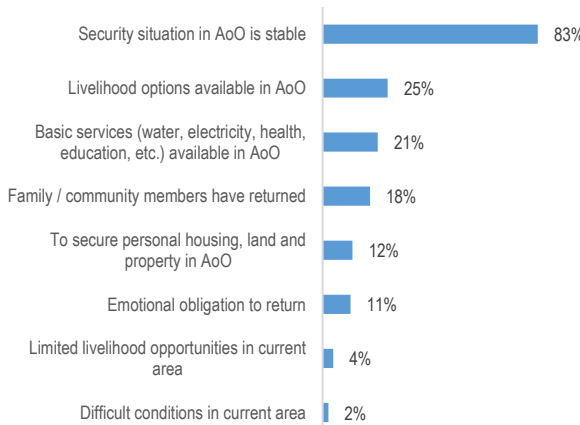

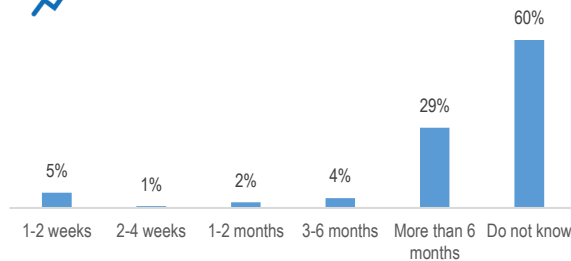
If yes, will you be going to your original home in your area of origin or will you live somewhere else?



If yes, what are the main reasons for why you would like to return to your area of origin?²

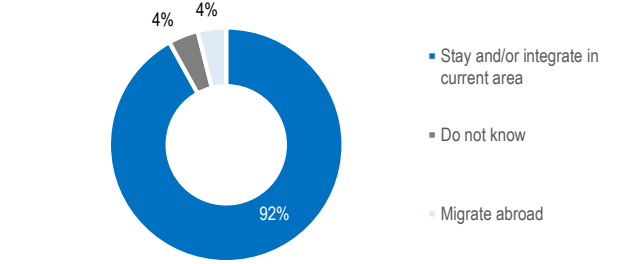


If yes, when do you think you will return?

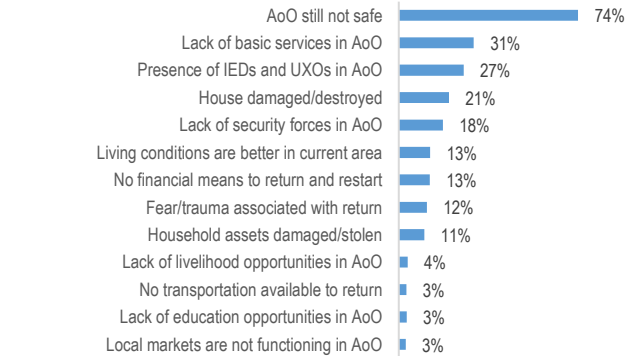

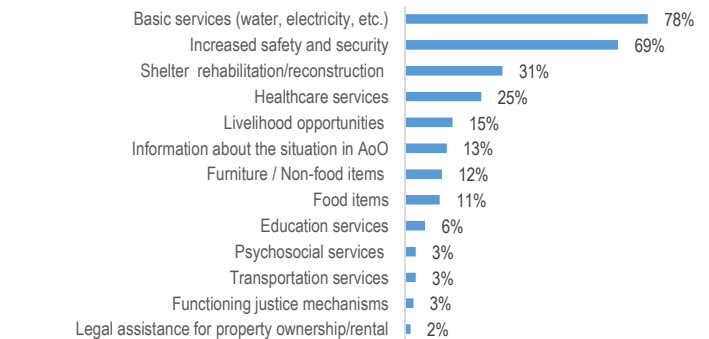
If not planning to return to your area of origin, where will you go?
