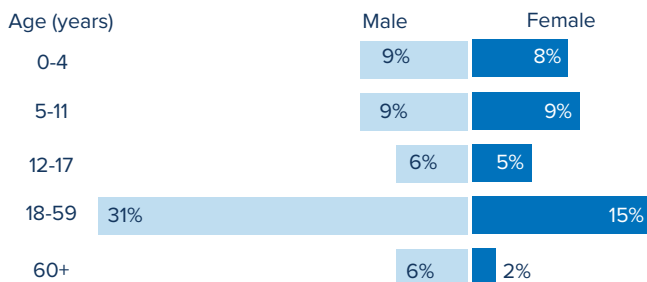
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

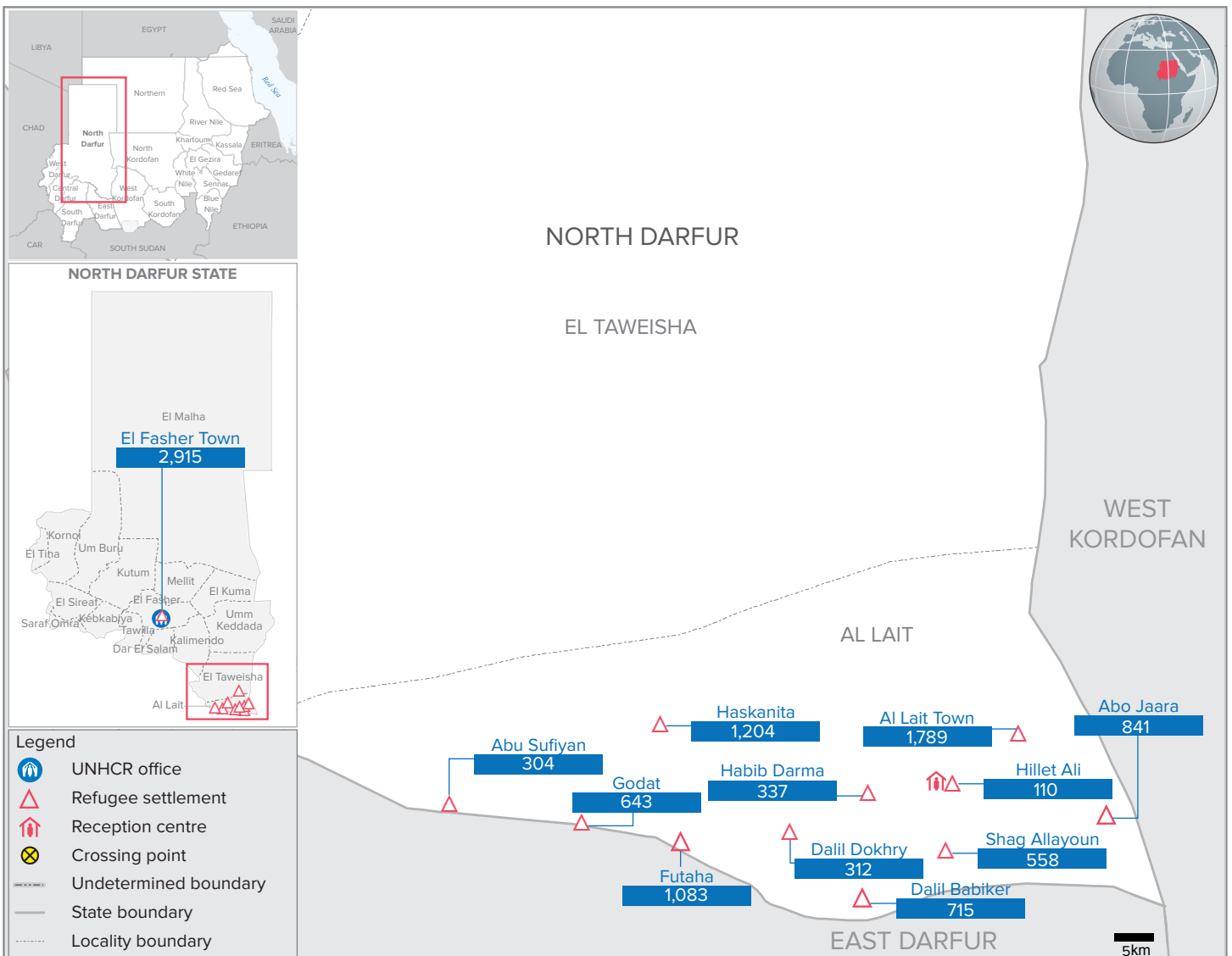

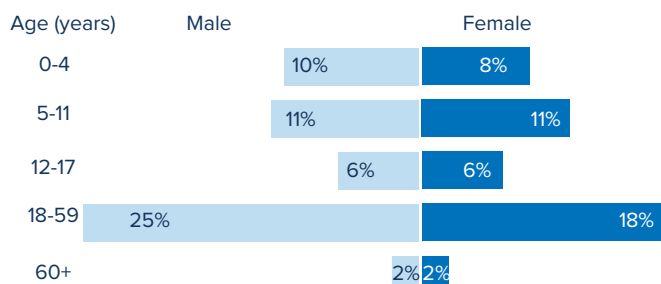
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

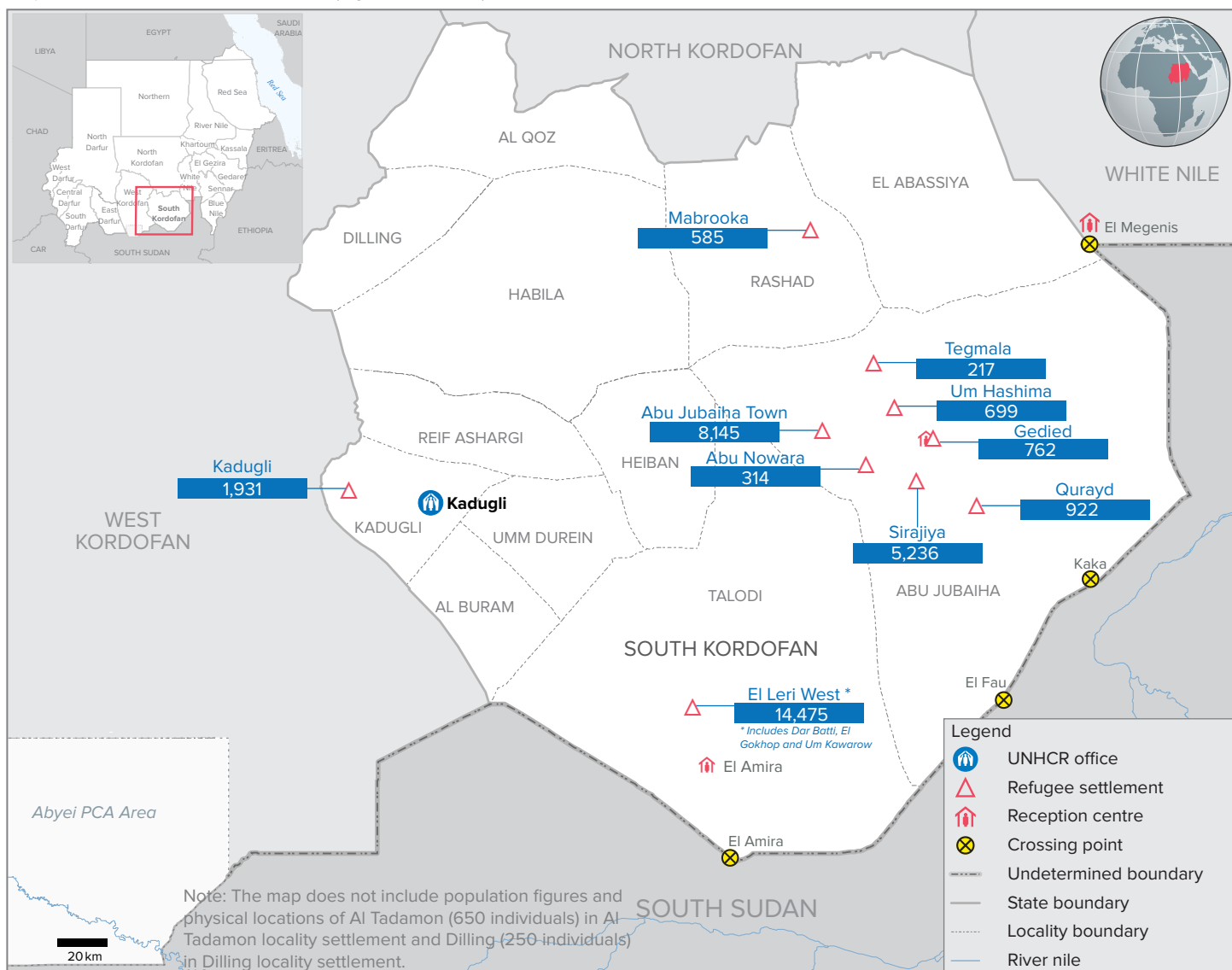
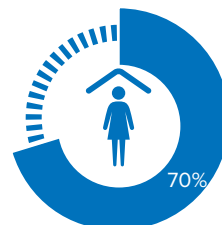
SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) **

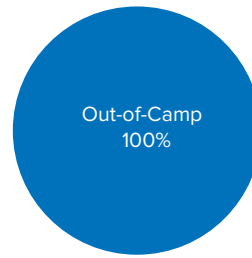

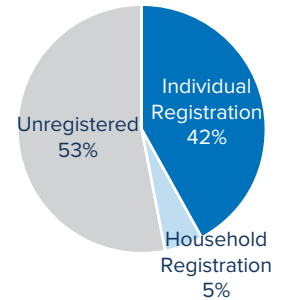

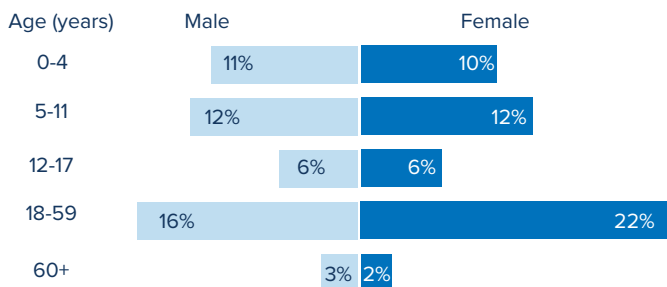
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

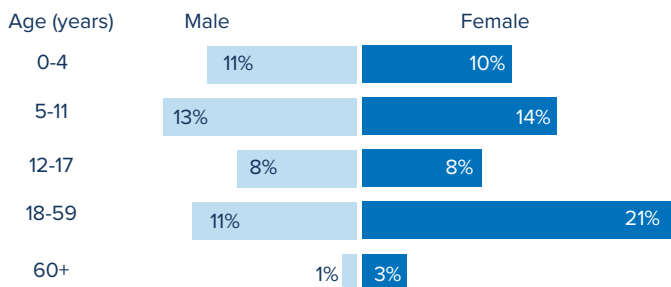
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION
