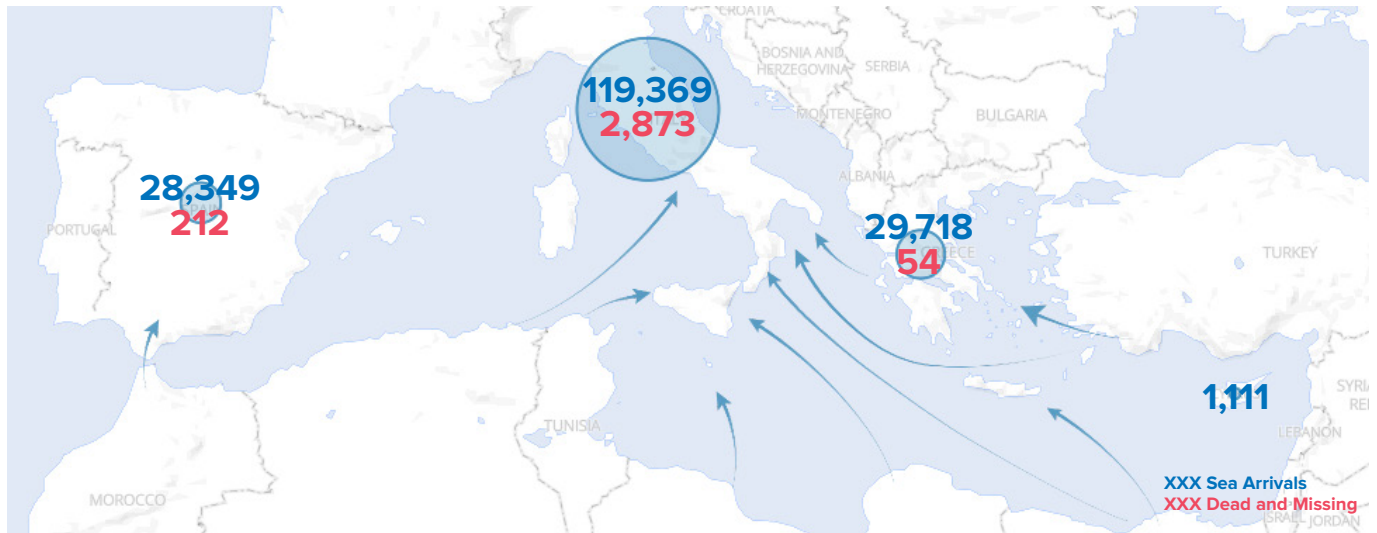

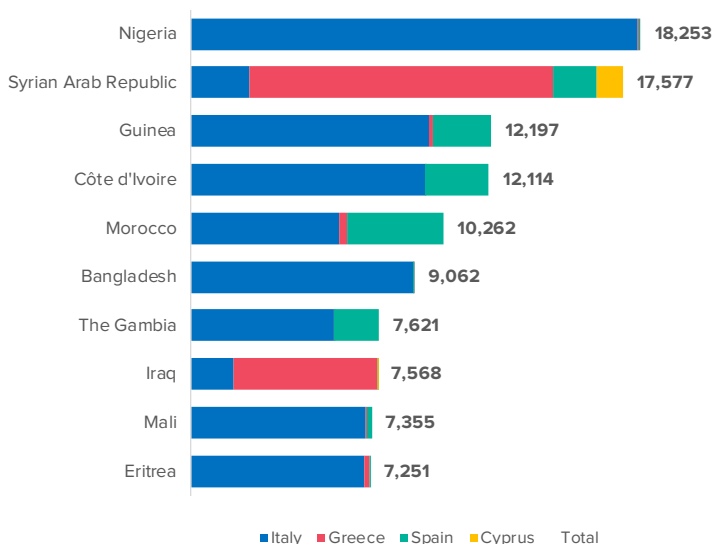

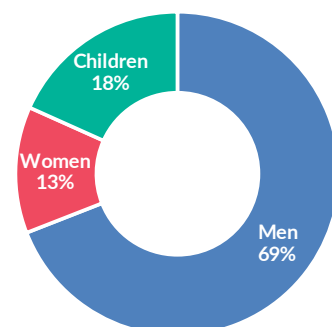
Top 10 nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals in 2017

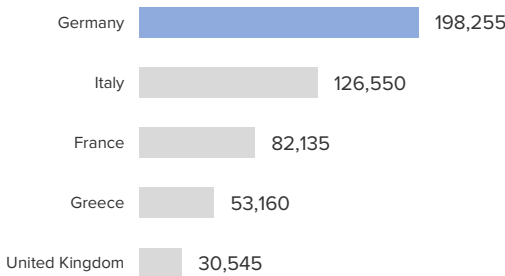

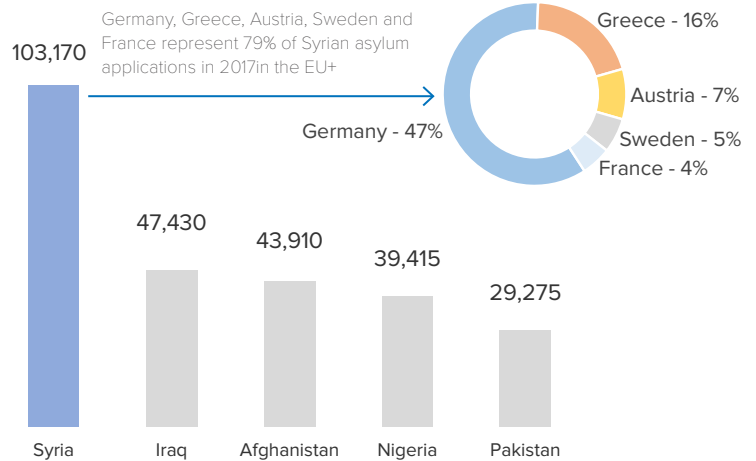

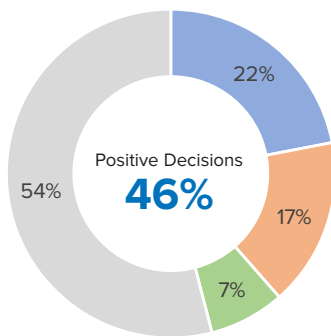
Most common countries of asylum in the EU+ in 2017



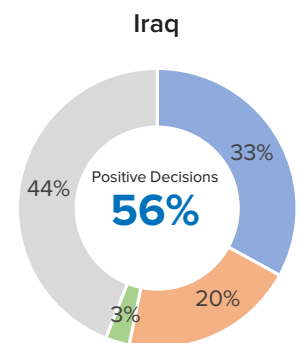
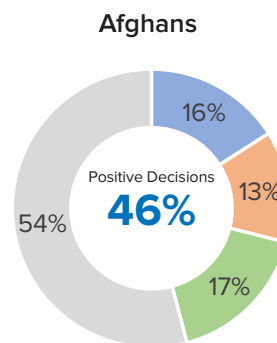
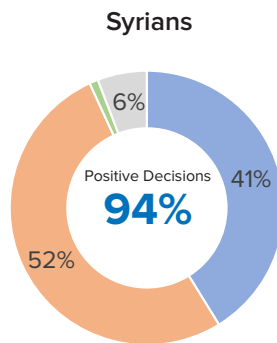
Most common nationalities of asylum applications in 2017

Top Nationalities of EU+ First Instance Decisions in 2017



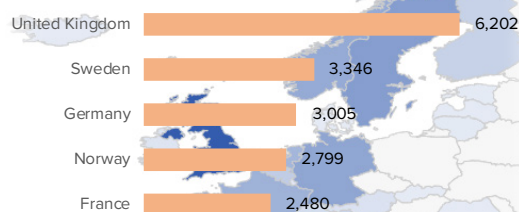

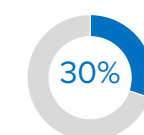

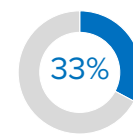
