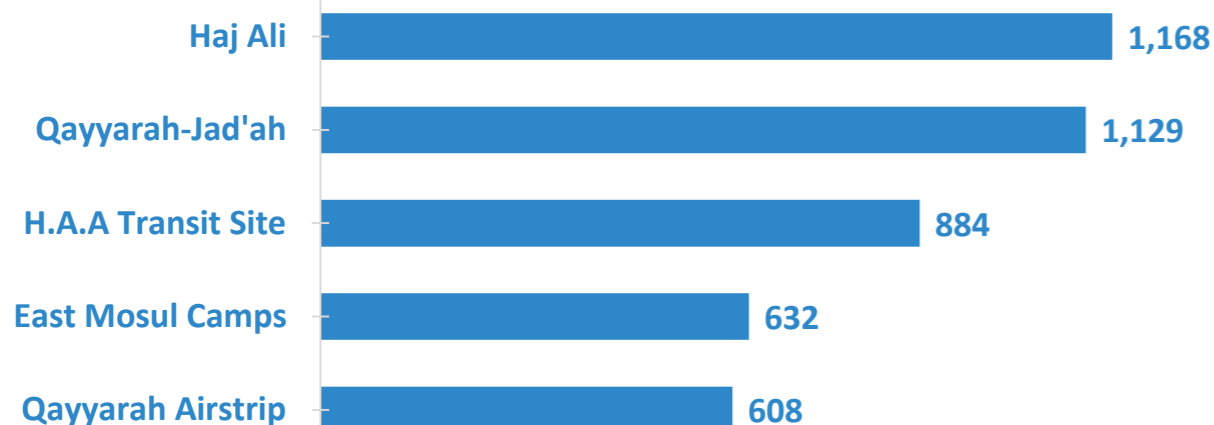




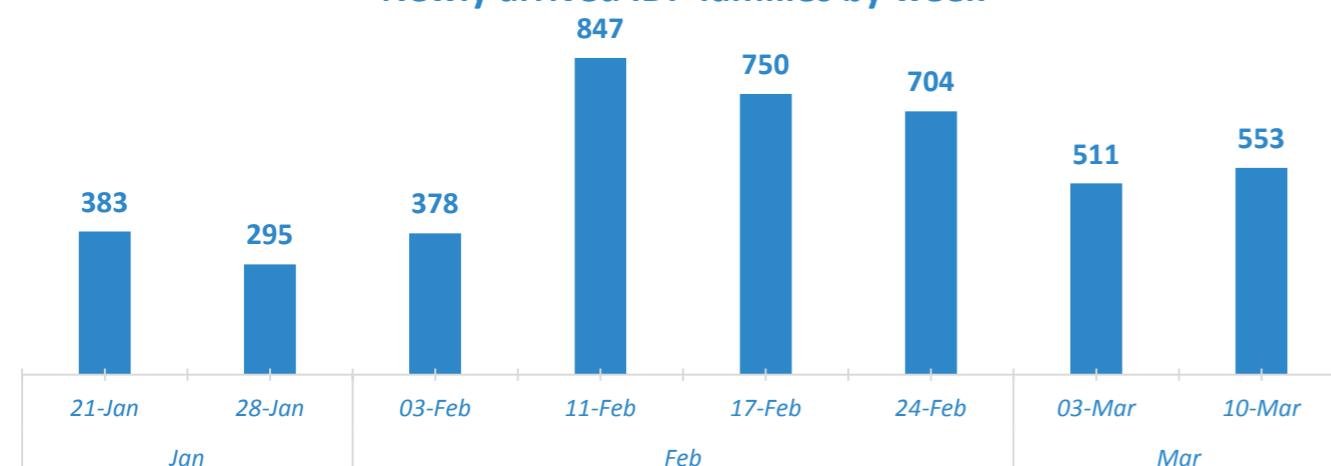

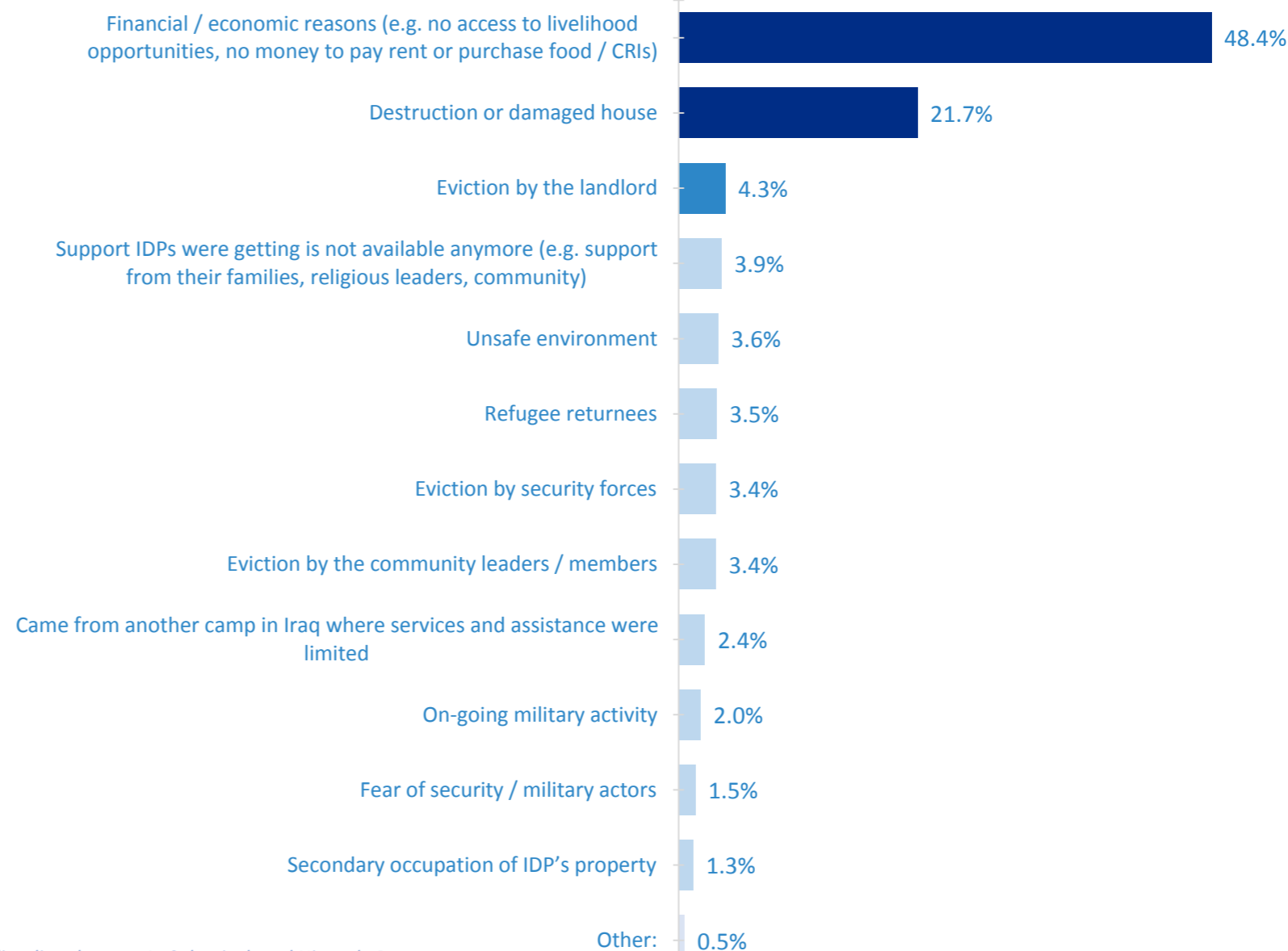
Newly arrived IDP families per site\*
