Presentation of MyHealth project

The main aim of MyHealth is to improve the healthcare access of vulnerable immigrants and refugees (VMR) newly arrived to Europe, by developing and implementing models based on the knowhow of a European multidisciplinary network. MyHealth Project will focus on women and unaccompanied minors newly arrived in Europe (less than five years).

- -Define and develop health intervention strategies in mental health as well as communicable and non-communicable diseases

	 -Develop an ICT based platform to support tools, enhance health applications development and health information. -Implement defined strategies and models in pilot over the hospital participating in the consortium. -Train and involve key actors (from users to management) in the health system value chain. -Ensure sound management and effective communication for MyHealth.
