

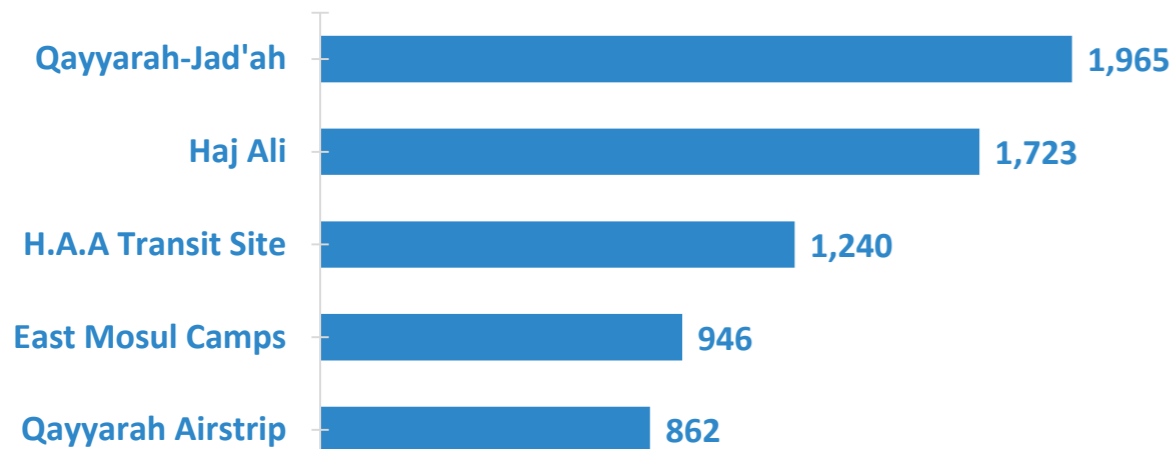

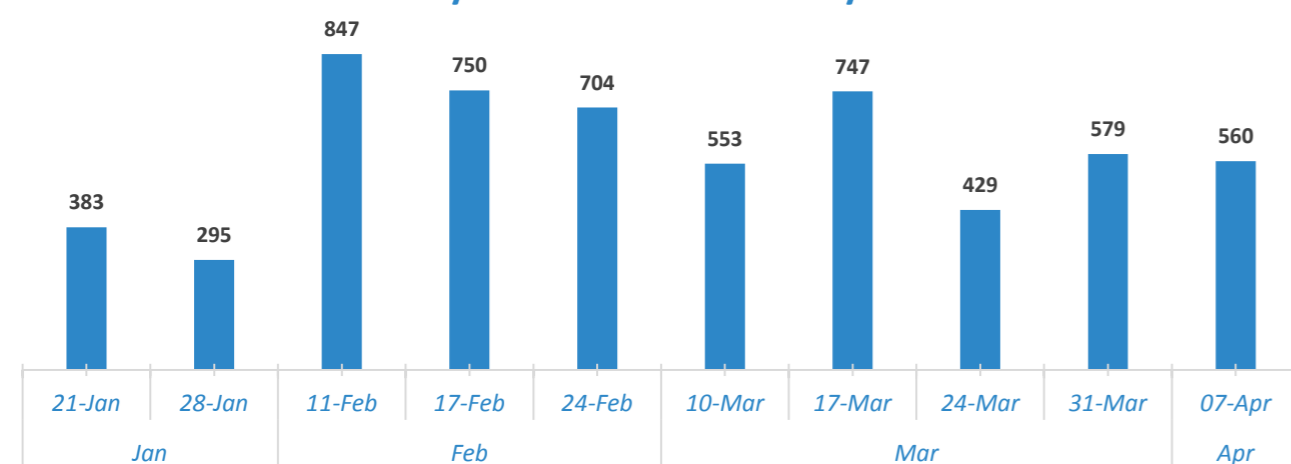

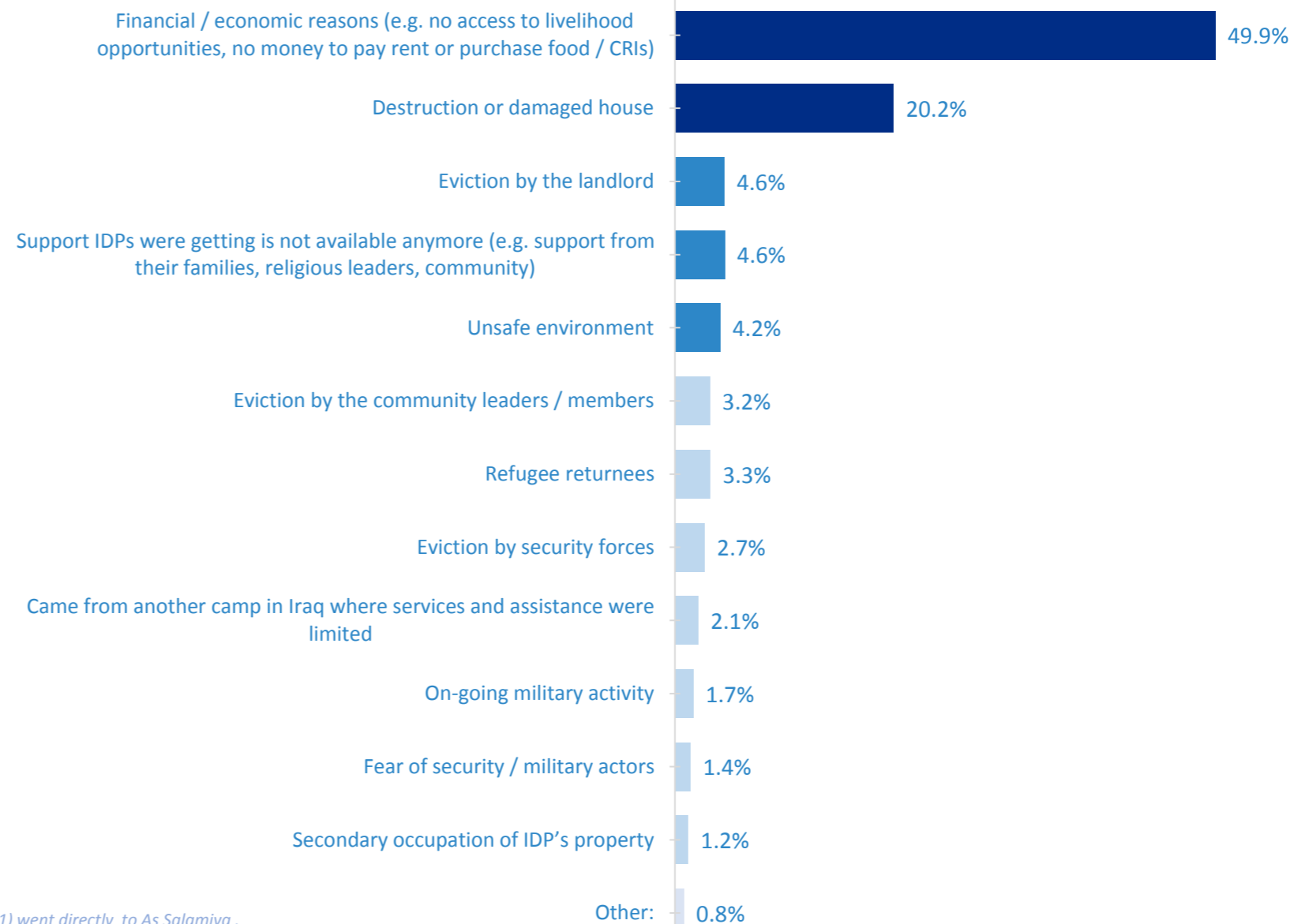
Newly arrived IDP families per site*
