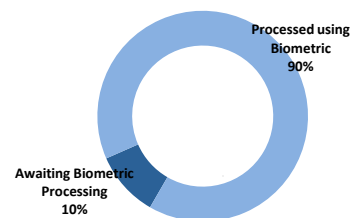

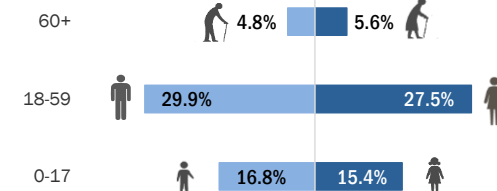

Age-Gender Breakdown



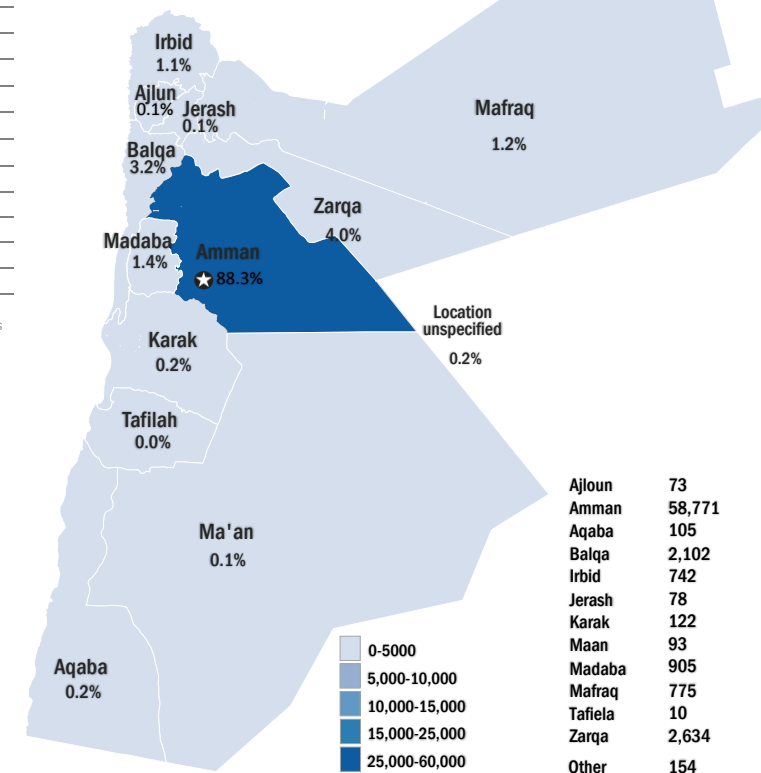
