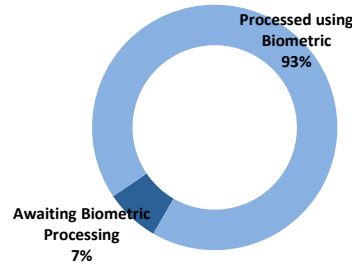

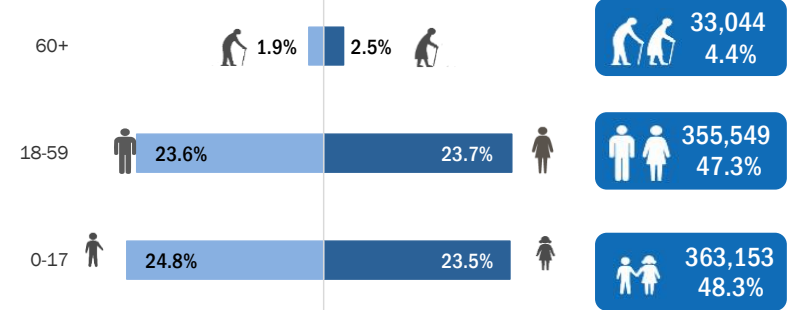

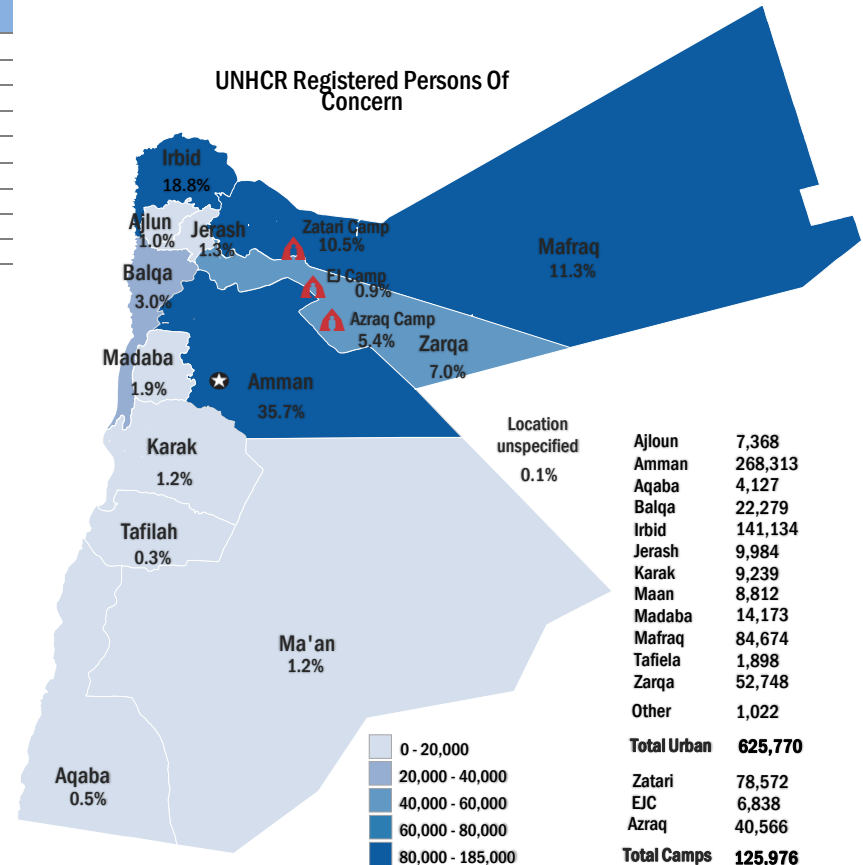

**Age-Gender Breakdown**

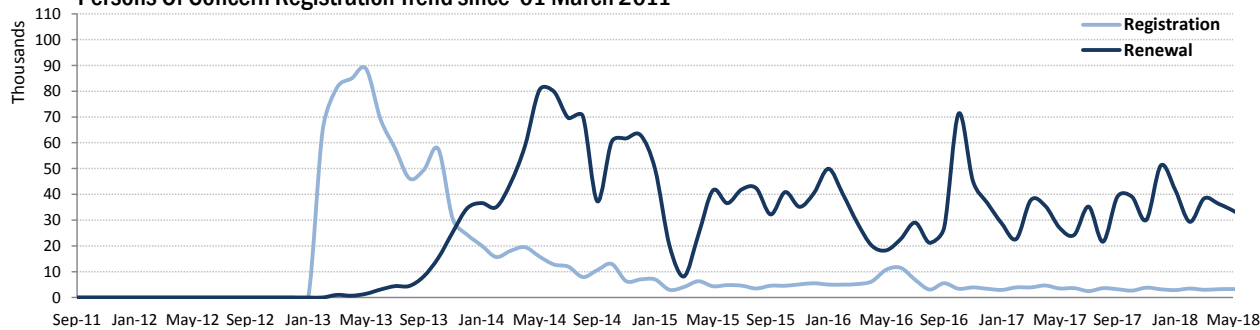


**UNHCR Registered Persons Of Concern**
