Shelter Guidelines – Decision Tree	 BN Coordinator presented the draft decision tree to be included as an annex to the Shelter Guidelines currently under preparation. Decision tree to be edited to reflect that harmonization information and tools are contained within the guidelines. Guidelines should include step relation to AAP and PSEA considerations. Decision tree to reflect that needs assessments for shelter activities may also rely on existing assessments and secondary data, as applicable. 	
Needs Assessment – EU Facility for Refugees in Turkey	 The EU Delegation to Turkey has contracted a team of technical experts to carry out a needs assessment for the FRiT with the objectives of: Identifying remaining/unmet needs of refugees and most affected host communities in Turkey. Assessing existing gaps in view of needs and past/on-going government and donor interventions. Suggesting areas where further measures would still be needed in the medium and long-term. Exploring opportunities for further coordination and alignment of actions being funded by government and donor community. 	 BN partners may revert bilaterally to consultants with inputs and comments.
