# MAIN ACHIEVEMENTS Q2



- 1,710 refugee households affected by conflict benefited from NFI assistance (457) and emergency shelter assistance (1,253).
- 377 refugee households provided with transitional/permanent shelter

### PROTECTION

- 115,218 refugees registered and issued w/documentation - 56 UASC in alternative care/ benefited from follow-up - 3,593 persons (staff, community members, authorities) trained on protection

## WASH

- 16.6L of potable water available per refugee per day in the camp
- 24,673 out-of-camp refugees had access to a minimum of 15L of potable water per day

#### **EDUCATION**

- 1,818 boys and girls learning in protected learning spaces
- 605 boys and girls learning in Distance Education Centres

### LIVELIHOODS & ENVIRONMENT

- 13,495 refugees in the camp had access to gas

- 3,475 refugee households received agricultural/livestock support in kind or in cash
