# Returns from Greece to Turkey

In the framework of the EU-TUR Statement. Source: Press Releases, Greek Ministry of Citizen Protection.

### Overview

The majority of those returned to Turkey are **Pakistani nationals (39 per cent of total)**. **Syrians** constitute **18 per cent** of the total number of those returned, and are followed by **Algerians**, **Bangladeshis** and **Afghans**.

In total, **304 Syrians** have been returned to Turkey to date. **31** of them have been returned on the basis that their asylum claims were found inadmissible at 2nd instance.

Of all those returned, **47 per cent** did not **express a will to apply for asylum** or **withdrew their will to apply for asylum** or **withdrew their asylum claims** in Greece.
