Seasonal Projects

Ramadan Program and Qurbani Project:

- 1. Food Distribution for at least 2,000 poorest family annually.
- 2. Iftar days, number of delivered persons per years 3,000 since 2015.
- 3. Clothing 1,400 vulnerable kids yearly
- 4. Eid Ceremony for 1,000 needy kid with mother by one year.

UMR slaughter every year around 200 goat/ sheep then distribute for each vulnerable family 4 kilo fresh meat.

Main Challenges

Delay issues to implement in-kind donations(non food items distributions) due to long procedures with Jordan government in regard to official permissions. 14

Due to lack fund, UMR not able to serve all vulnerable persons in Jordan.

Lessons learnt

Improve quality of presented services rather than just focussing on number of beneficiaries. 15
