

Profiling of Venezuelan populations in Peru

+ 560,000 Venezuelans live in Peru

Combined data from Migration Peru and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs indicate that the largest numbers of Venezuelans live in Lima and Callao, with increasing numbers in Cusco, Arequipa, La Libertad and Tumbes, among others.

Why profiling?

To have better, stronger data on trends, characteristics, vulnerabilities and capacities of Venezuelans settling in Peru, that will be used for a more effective, targeted and programmatic response to meet the most pressing needs through a community based approach.

What will we know?

Household composition, living conditions, access to basic services, access to rights such as health and education, risks such as exploitation, abuse, discrimination, gender based violence, access to livelihood opportunities and overall capacities of Venezuelan populations.

How

Sample based survey, nationally representative, 3500 Venezuelan people to be interviewed. Expected preliminary results by end December 2018.
Government leadership through the National Statistics Institute (INEI), and Inter agency financial and technical support.

Where?

Lima, Trujillo, Tumbes, Cusco, Arequipa.
