




64% of secondary and tertiary referrals were for obstetrics & gynaecology.

Hypertension and asthma were the highest reported chronic health conditions, each with a proportional morbidity of 35%. There is a slight decrease in trends of diabetes in comparison with the previous months. Trends in chronic health conditions varied as a result of clinic accessibility challenges. Management of chronic diseases requires regular periodic visits to monitor diseases and evaluate therapeutic outcomes, which necessitates enhanced accessibility of those morbid diseases to the health care facility.












