Welcome and introduction	<p>UNHCR Chair welcomed group participants. Action points were reviewed as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">The BNWG will have a continuous standing agenda point: winterization	
3RP planning	<ul style="list-style-type: none">3RP timelines and background were explainedThe 3RP narrative for the Basic Needs sector were reviewed and the following comments were given:The assumption that the protracted crisis is still increasing vulnerabilities was questioned. This assumption needs to be quantified.The narrative from the last 3RP is still valid, changes in camp population and population figures in Turkey cannot be estimated. One participant suggested the inclusion of cash for work in the basic needs section.The calculation of people in need needs to be revised given the changes in the Turkish economy over the last year.WHH mentioned that they will appeal for shelter and cash (winterization).The indicator 1.3.3 is not clear since the WASH rehabilitation in accommodations is part of the shelter rehabilitationNone of the participants is planning NFI distributions in 2019.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Refer cash for work guidance to the CBI-TWGClarify indicator 1.3.3

Planning for Winter 2018/9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> IOM shared a first draft of 4Ws. So far no overlaps are detected IOM will soon share draft SOPs Due to the budget cut, IOM will not prioritize the ESSN beneficiaries for this year but depending on to the household level assessment that they will be able to include very few number of ESSN beneficiaries if they still need winterization support.
