



(Policy level)

- Raise up advocacy level to return old access policy (Brussel conference 2 + MDA)
- Effective coordination mechanisms in place (inter sector, sector, subsector and donor)

(Resilience level)


- Capacity building of human resources at MoH

Key Achievements


(Refugee Response)

- Absorb shock from change of policy
- Responding to the immediate health needs of new arrivals and berm population.
- Maintain essential package of health services for camps refugees
- Quality sexual reproductive health services maintained.
- Community health interventions including IYCF maintained.
- Mental health services provided through PHC clinics and community mental health workers.
- Sector Response Plan in place
- Sector Work Plan developed and tracked
- JRP/3RP produced and submitted timely



Refugee Response


Resilience Response
