




Country Fact Sheet
July 2019

UNHCR Ukraine has been working in Ukraine since 1992. The UN Refugee Agency has been providing humanitarian assistance to refugees and internally displaced persons in Ukraine since 1992. In 2019, UNHCR assisted 1.5 million people in Ukraine, including 1.2 million internally displaced persons and 300,000 refugees. UNHCR's total budget for 2019 is USD 28.3 million.

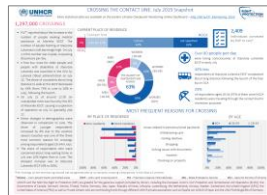

Operational Update
July 2019

UNHCR Ukraine's operational update for July 2019 shows that the agency has received USD 28.3 million in funding, with 37% of the budget allocated to protection activities. The number of internally displaced persons (IDPs) in Ukraine has increased to 1.2 million, and the number of refugees has reached 300,000.




