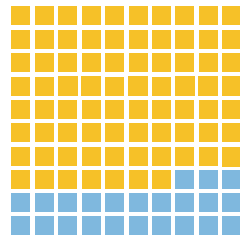
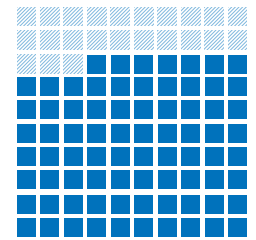

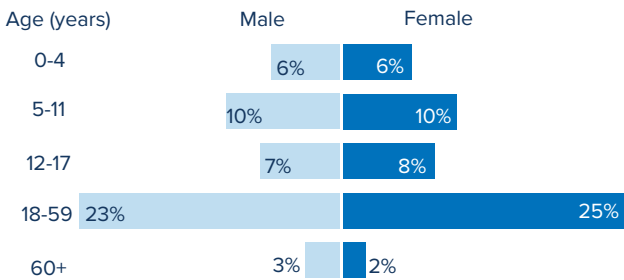


POPULATION DISTRIBUTION



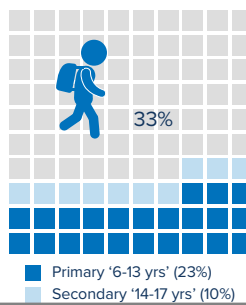

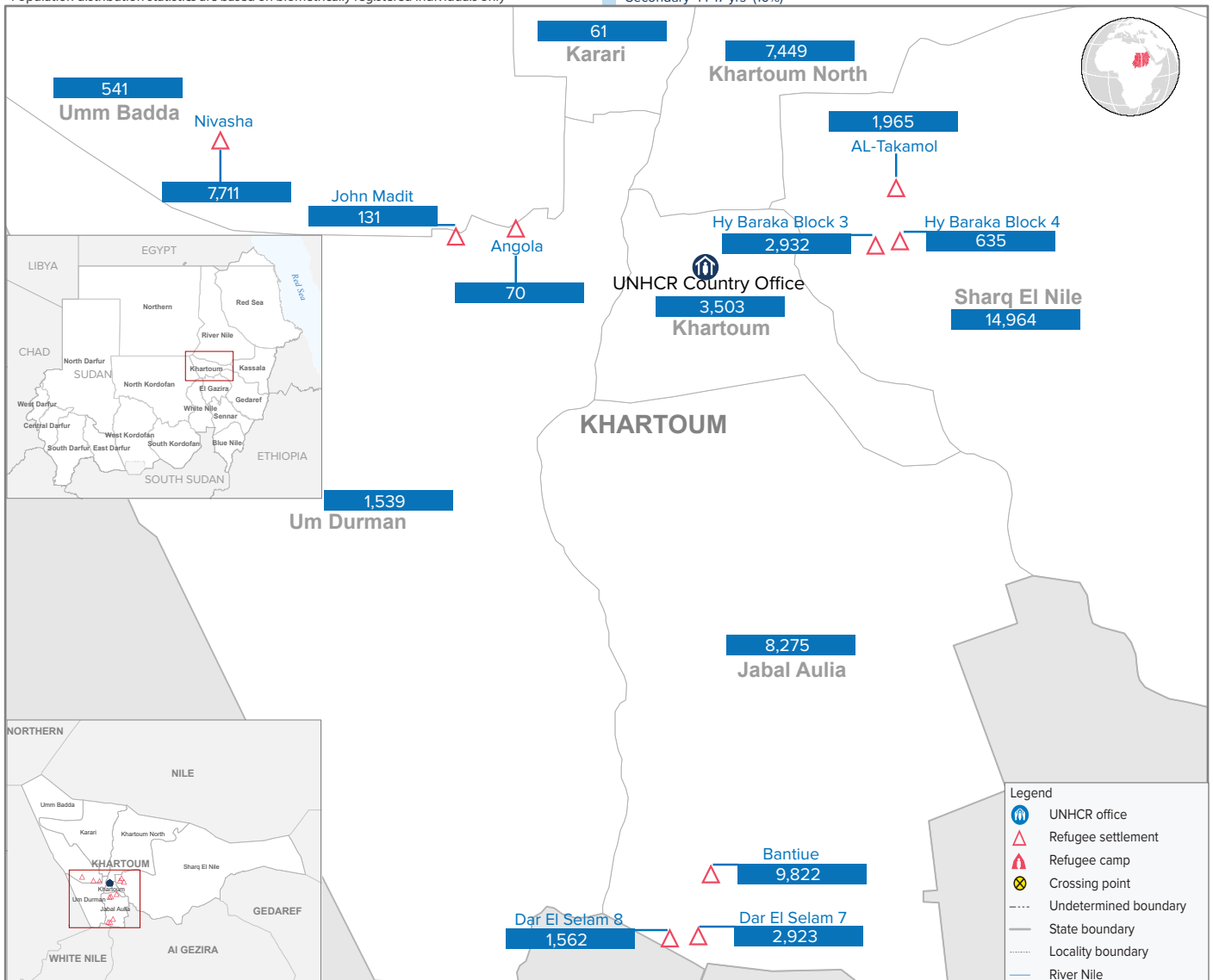
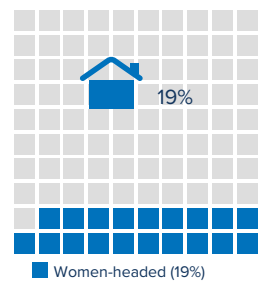
SCHOOL- AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) ****

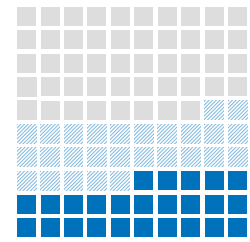

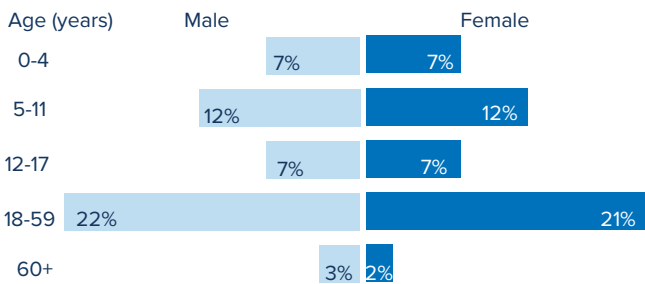
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

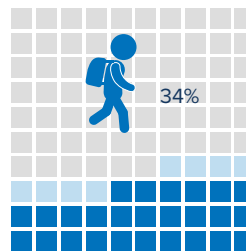

AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN ****



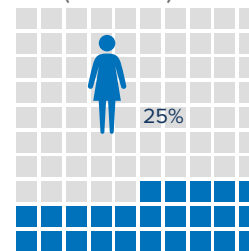

SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS) ****

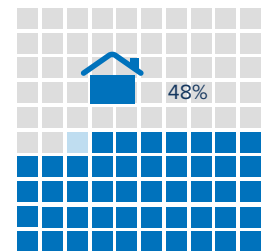

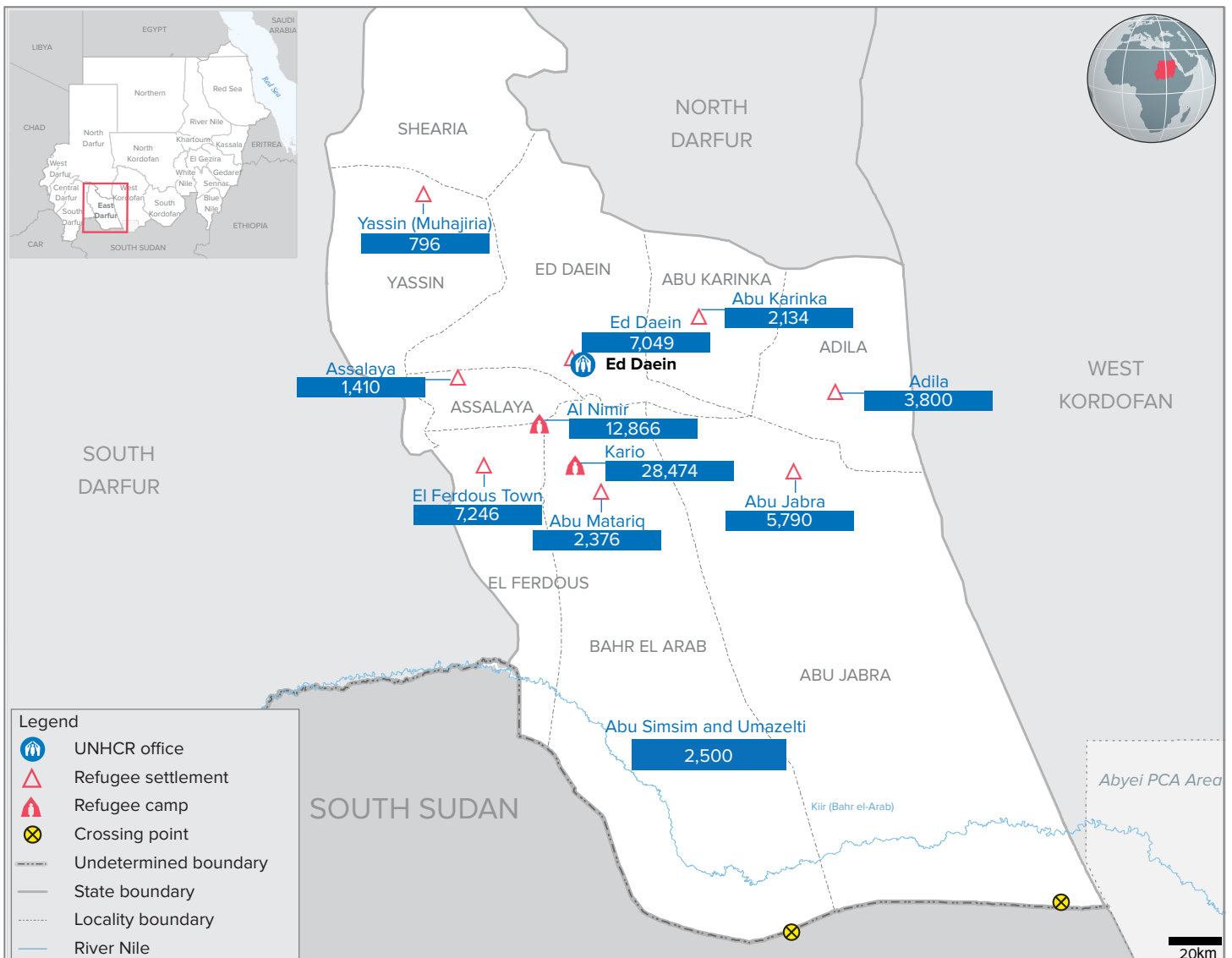

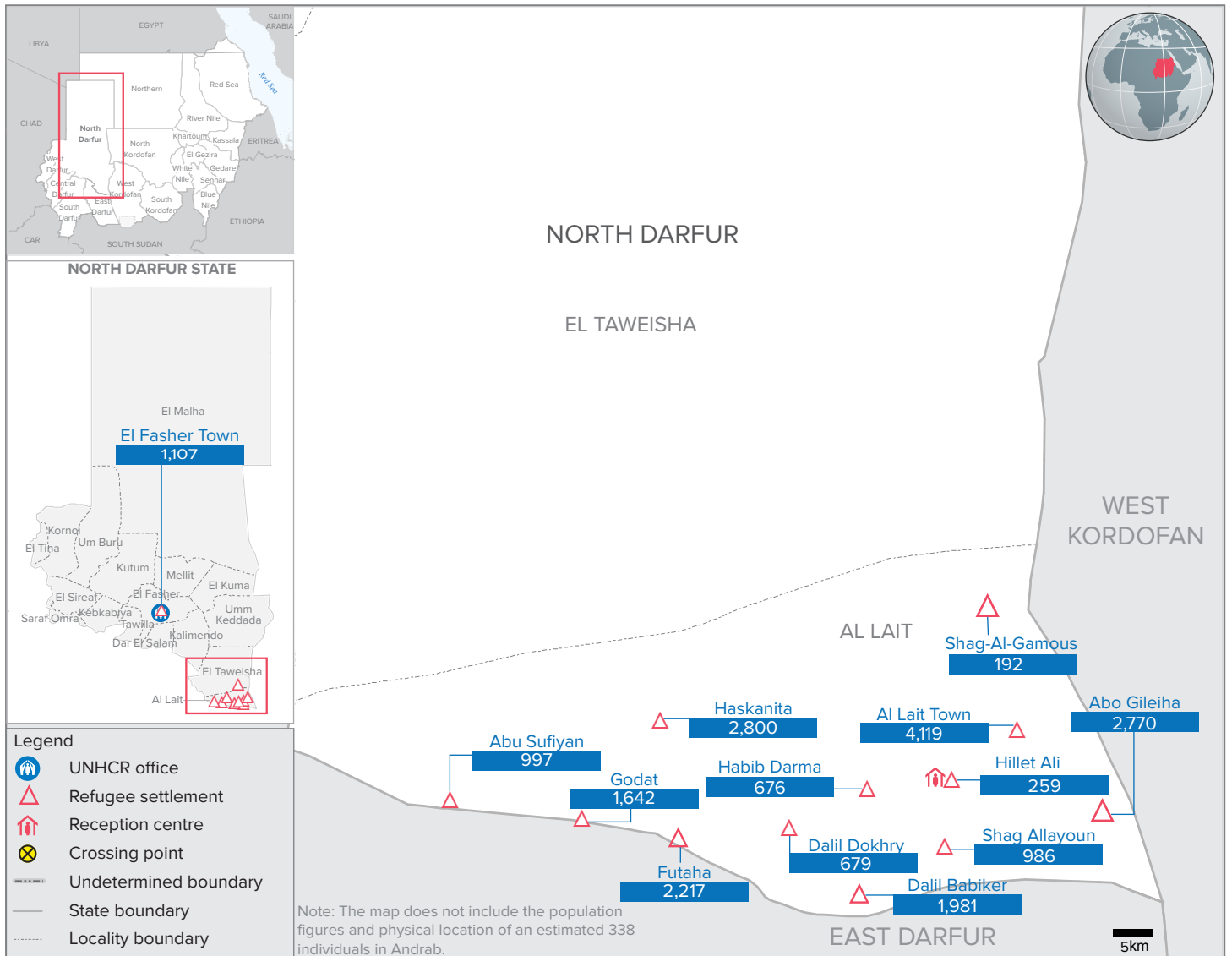

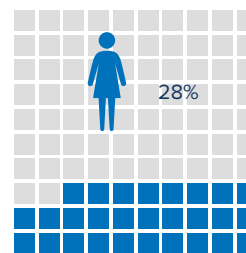

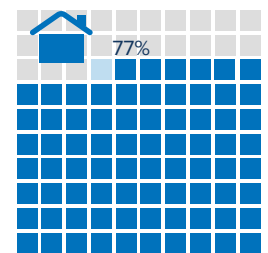

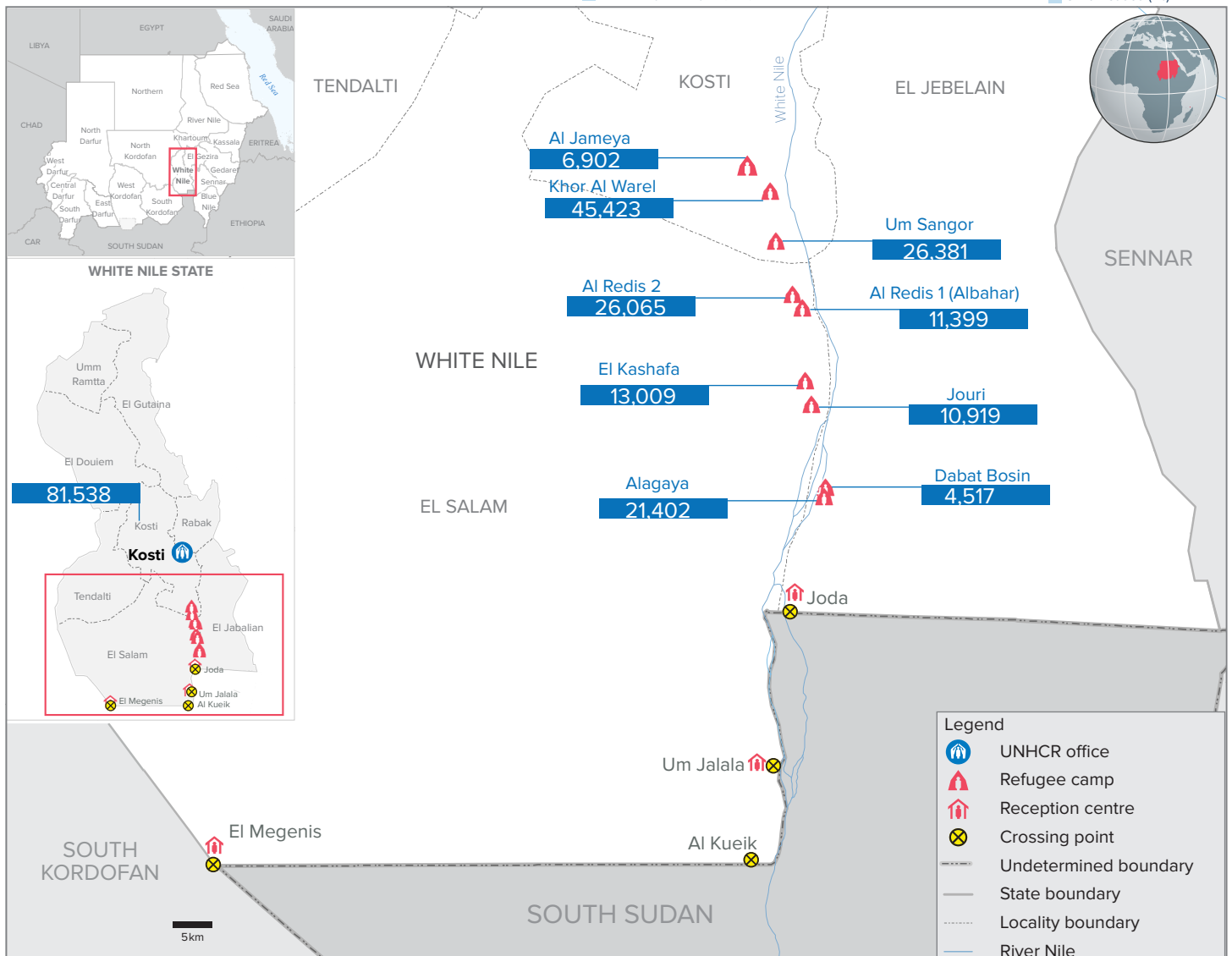

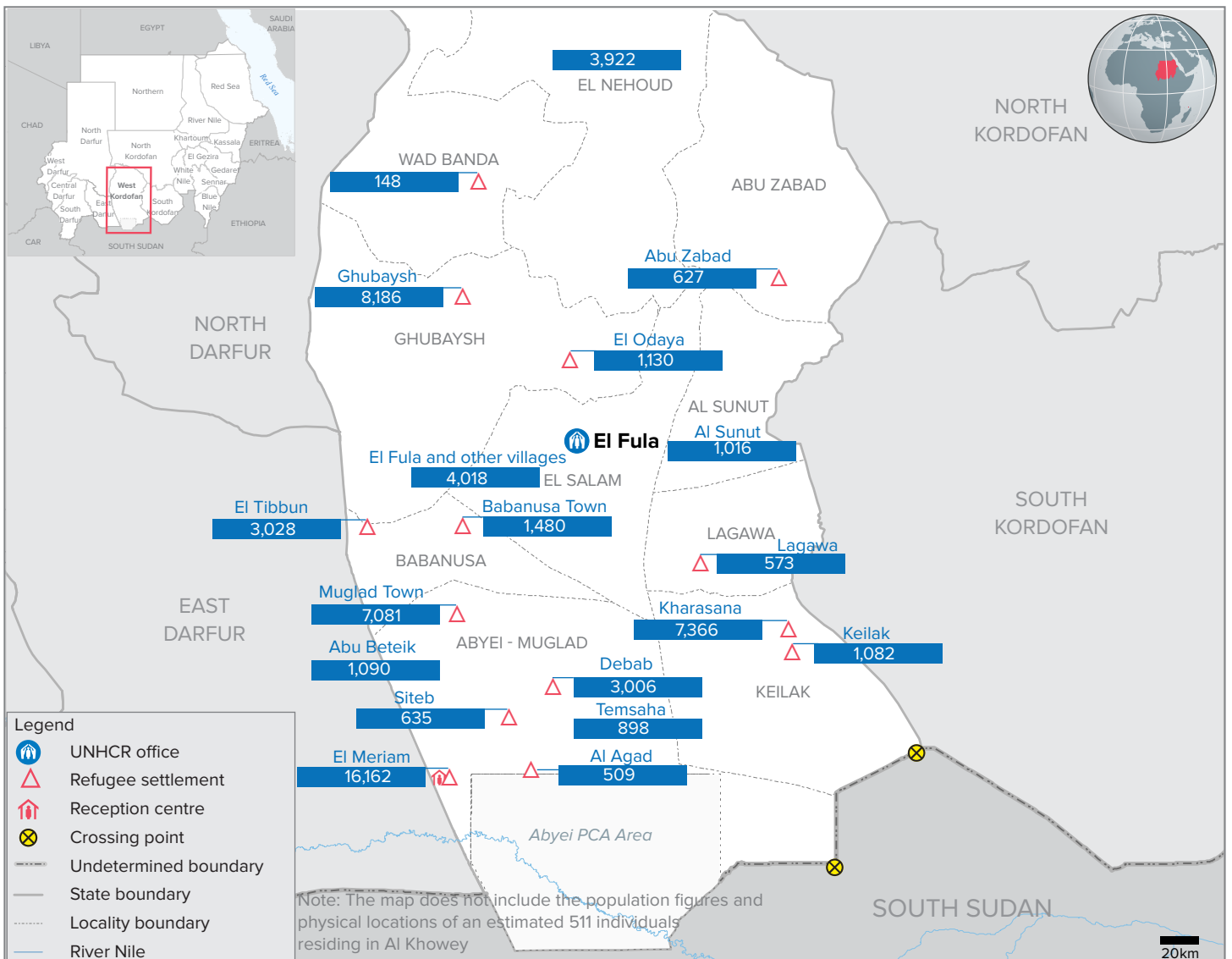

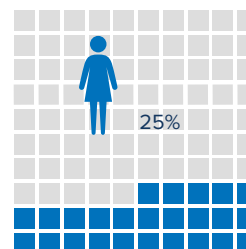

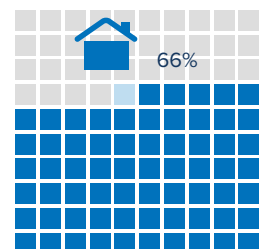

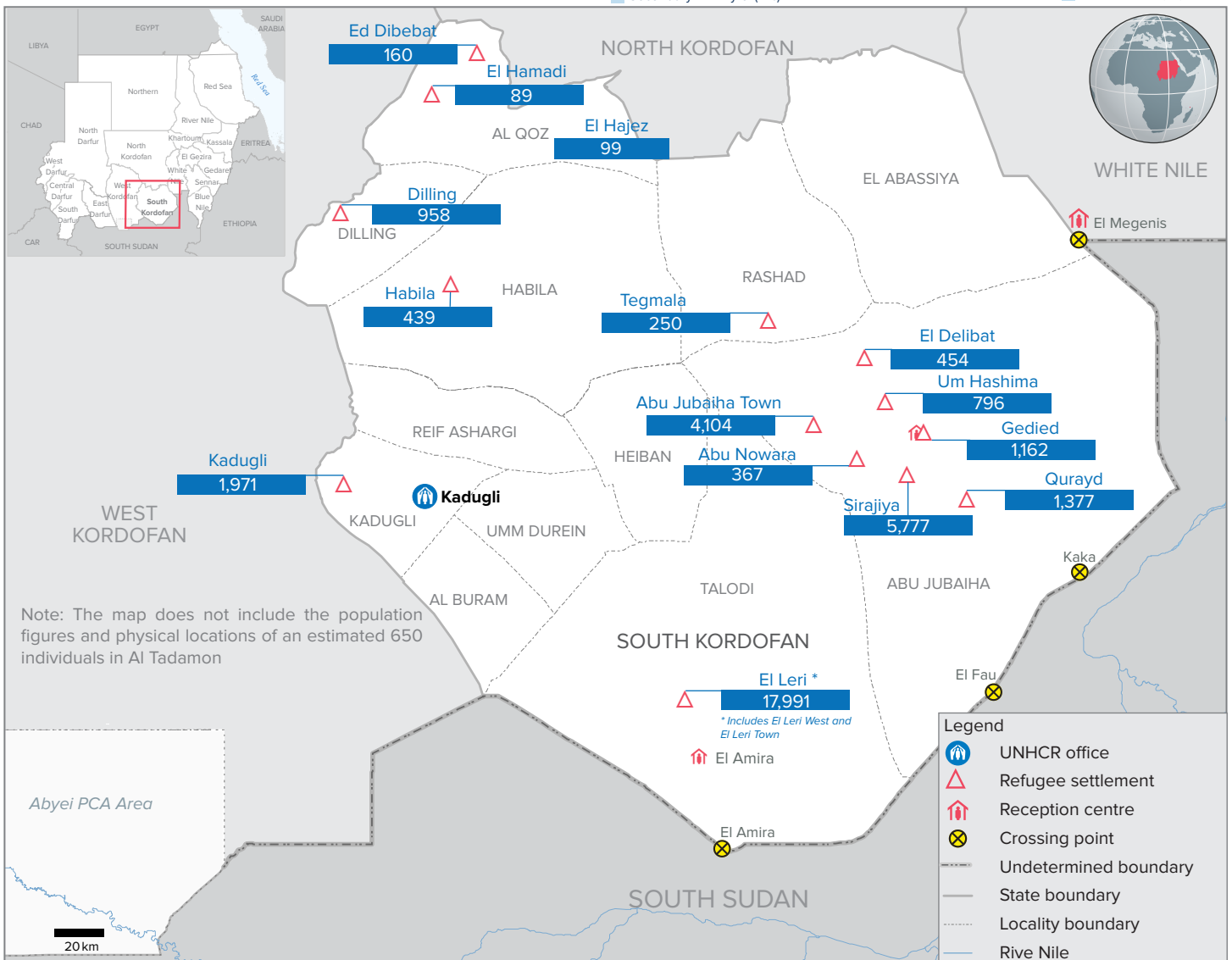
