









*In March 2020, there was a decrease of 5,901 refugee and asylum seekers individuals due to resettlement (11 persons), spontaneous departure (210 persons), deaths and other closures (73 persons) and 5,607 persons were inactivated because of no-show during BIMS verification exercise as opposed to an increase of newly registered 117 refugees and asylum-seekers and 79 new-born babies (74 Ethiopians, 25 Yemenis and 18 Syrians).

The Biometrics Identity Management System (BIMS) verification exercise of refugees and asylum-seekers was suspended in Somaliland in order to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.
