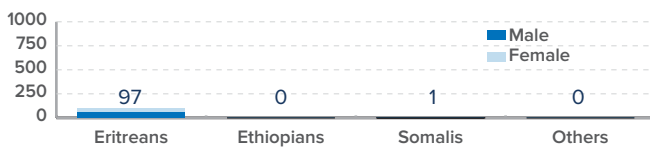


## ARRIVAL STATISTICS

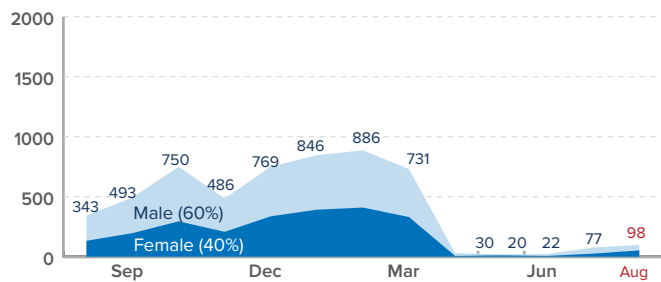

UNHCR continues to receive new arrivals in East Sudan, largely from Eritrea. The Commission for Refugees (COR) receives and assists asylum-seekers at the border where they are temporarily hosted in reception centres. Within 1-2 weeks they are transported to Shagarab camps where they undergo screening, registration, RSD<sup>2</sup> and two weeks quarantine while receiving life-saving services and shelter.

### ARRIVAL BY NATIONALITY (August 2020)

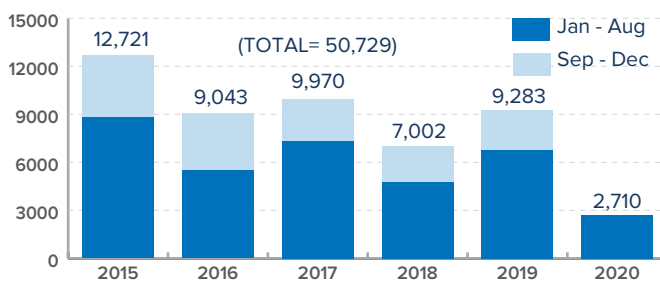


### ARRIVALS TREND (2019-2020)

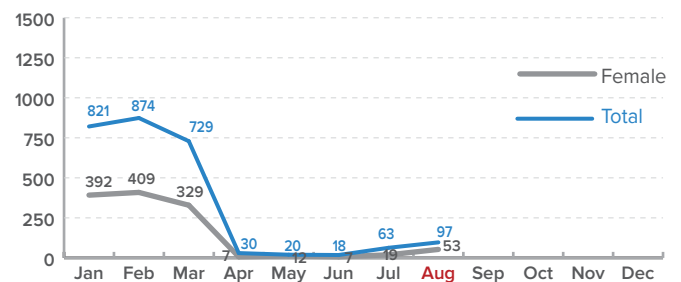

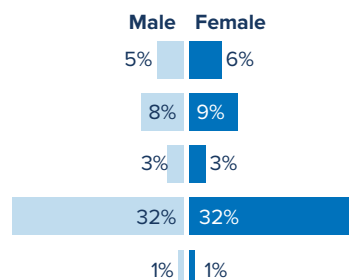

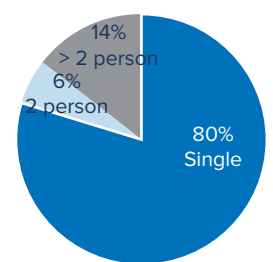
