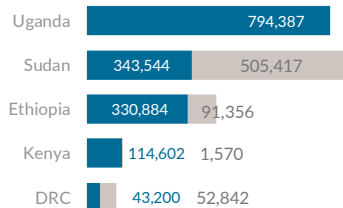
This represents those who had undergone individual registration (Registration Level 2) in DRC, Ethiopia, Kenya, Sudan and Uganda as of January 2019.

Approximately 71% of the displaced South Sudanese had been individually registered in the neighbouring countries of asylum.

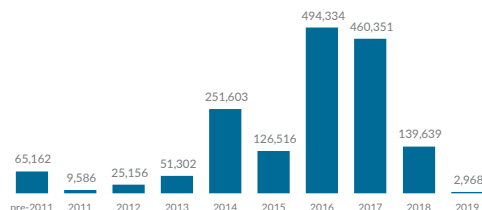
COUNTRY OF ASYLUM

YEAR OF ARRIVAL IN COUNTRY OF ASYLUM

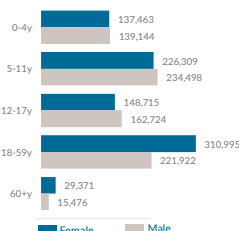

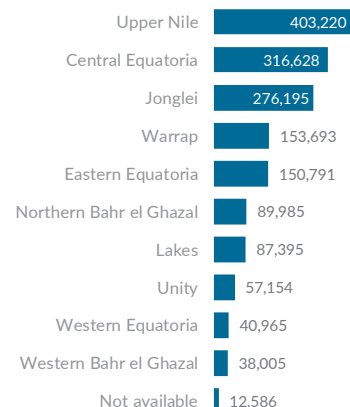

AGE AND GENDER COMPOSITION

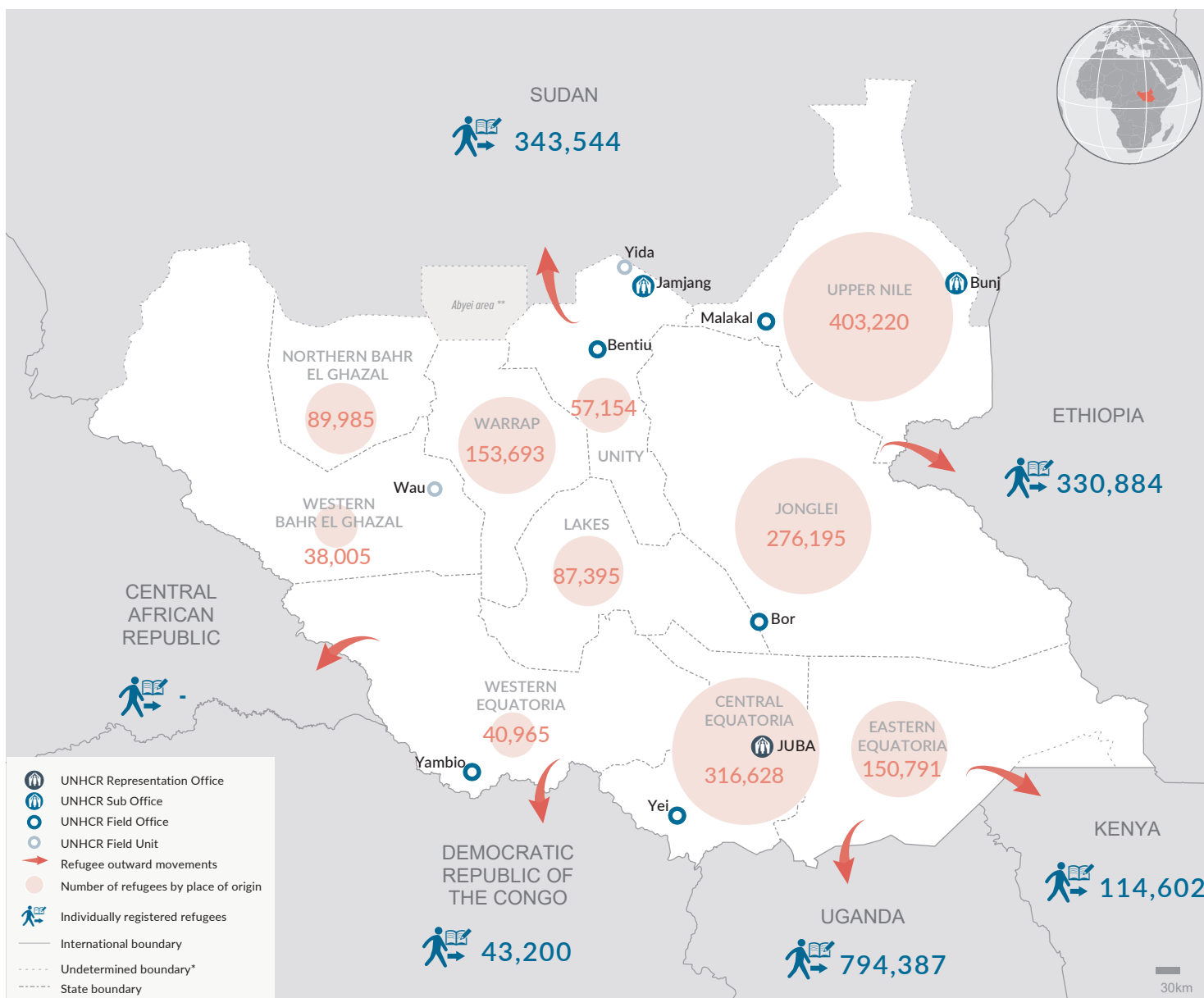


AREAS OF ORIGIN [STATES]
