

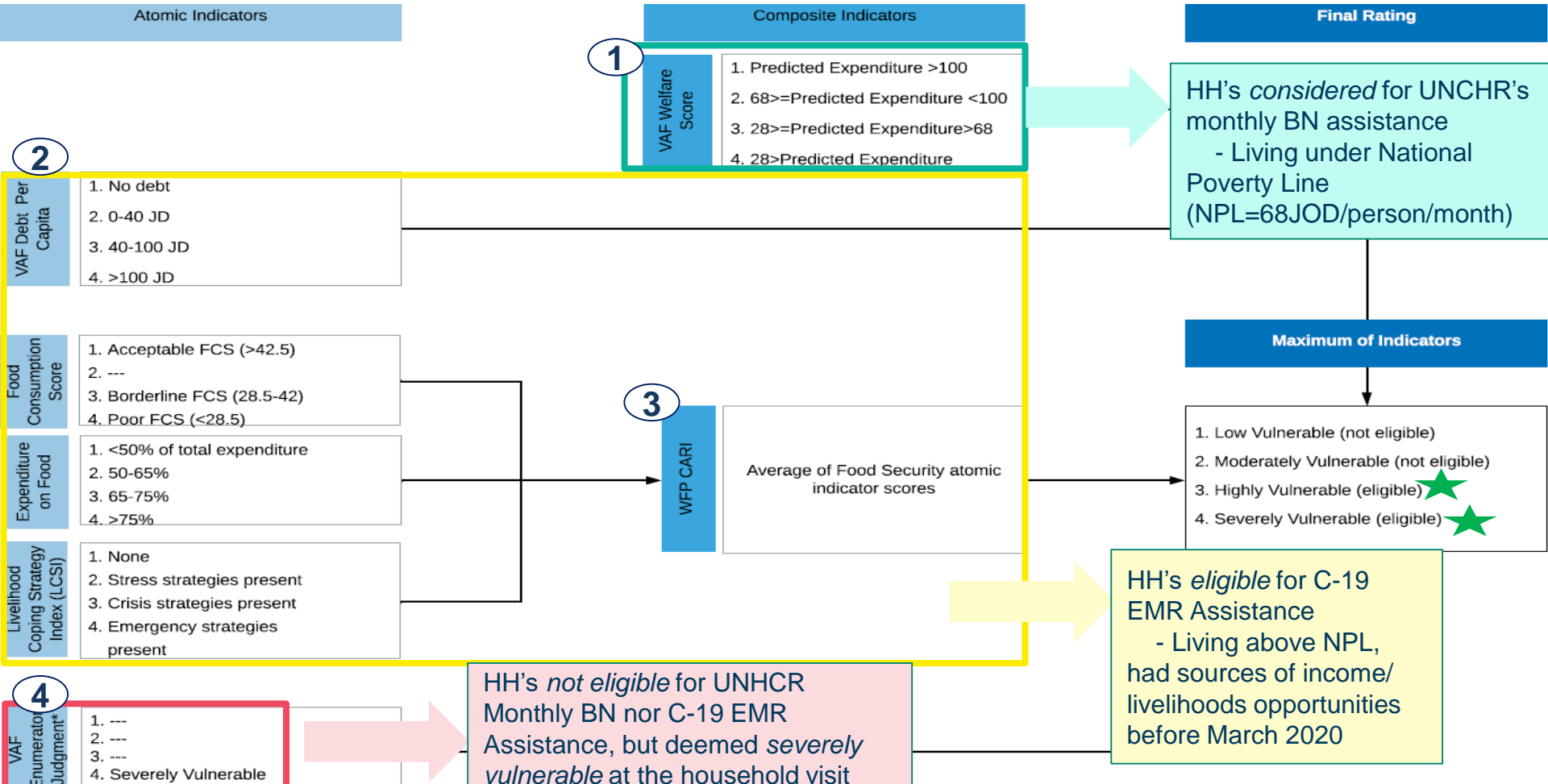
# Mainstreaming Protection in Targeting for Basic Needs' Winterization

- *Winter is coming...* Harsh winter months bring **additional cost** for families to meet basic needs (heater, gas, blankets)
- COVID-19 pandemic & lockdown had **negative impact across multi-sectoral vulnerability**:
  - Socio-economic (loss of livelihood, high level of debt)
  - Protection (GBV incidents, child labor)
- Jordan Humanitarian Fund (JHF) 2<sup>nd</sup> allocation will focus on **Winterization assistance (basic needs, shelter) + Protection**
  - Priority will be given to projects that address the needs of persons/households with **several protection vulnerabilities**

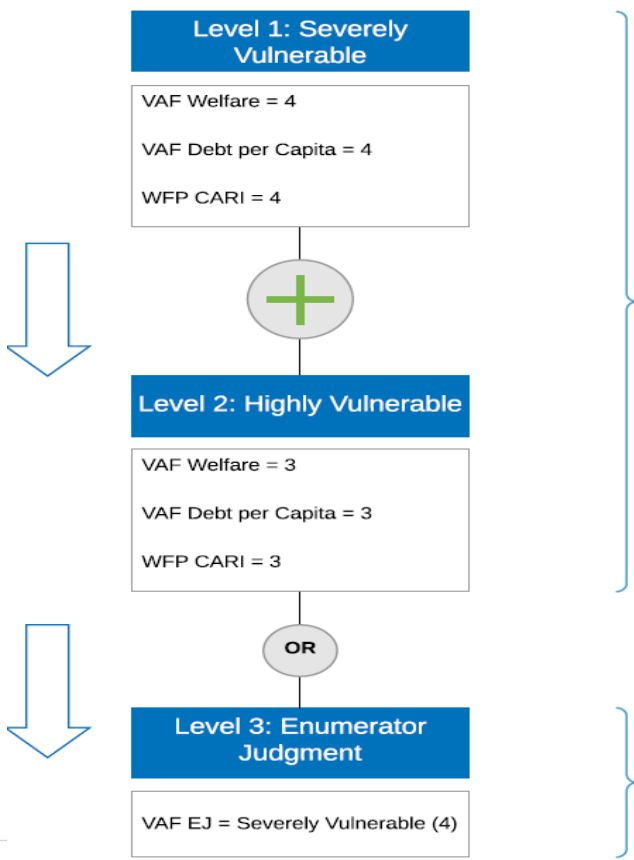

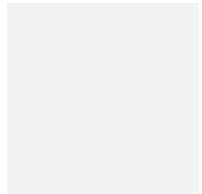


# Prioritization Criteria

Prioritized based on Specific Needs Elements



Prioritized based on Specific Needs Elements



- ### Protection Prioritization Elements
- Women at Risk
  - Child at Risk
  - Elderly at Risk
  - Single Parent or Caregiver
  - Disability or Severe Medical Conditions (SMC)

- ### Protection Prioritization Criteria
- Priority 1: All 5 elements: women at risk, child labour, elderly, single caregiver, SMC
  - Priority 2: Any combination of four elements eg, child marriage, elderly, single parent, disability
  - Priority 3: Any three of the elements
  - Priority 4: Any two of the elements
  - Priority 5: Any one of the elements
  - Priority 6: None of the elements

Combine scores rather than creating a weighted score

Level 1: Severely Vulnerable

VAF Welfare = 4

VAF Debt per Capita = 4

WFP CARI = 4



Level 2: Highly Vulnerable

VAF Welfare = 3

VAF Debt per Capita = 3

WFP CARI = 3

OR

Level 3: Enumerator Judgment

VAF EJ = Severely Vulnerable (4)
