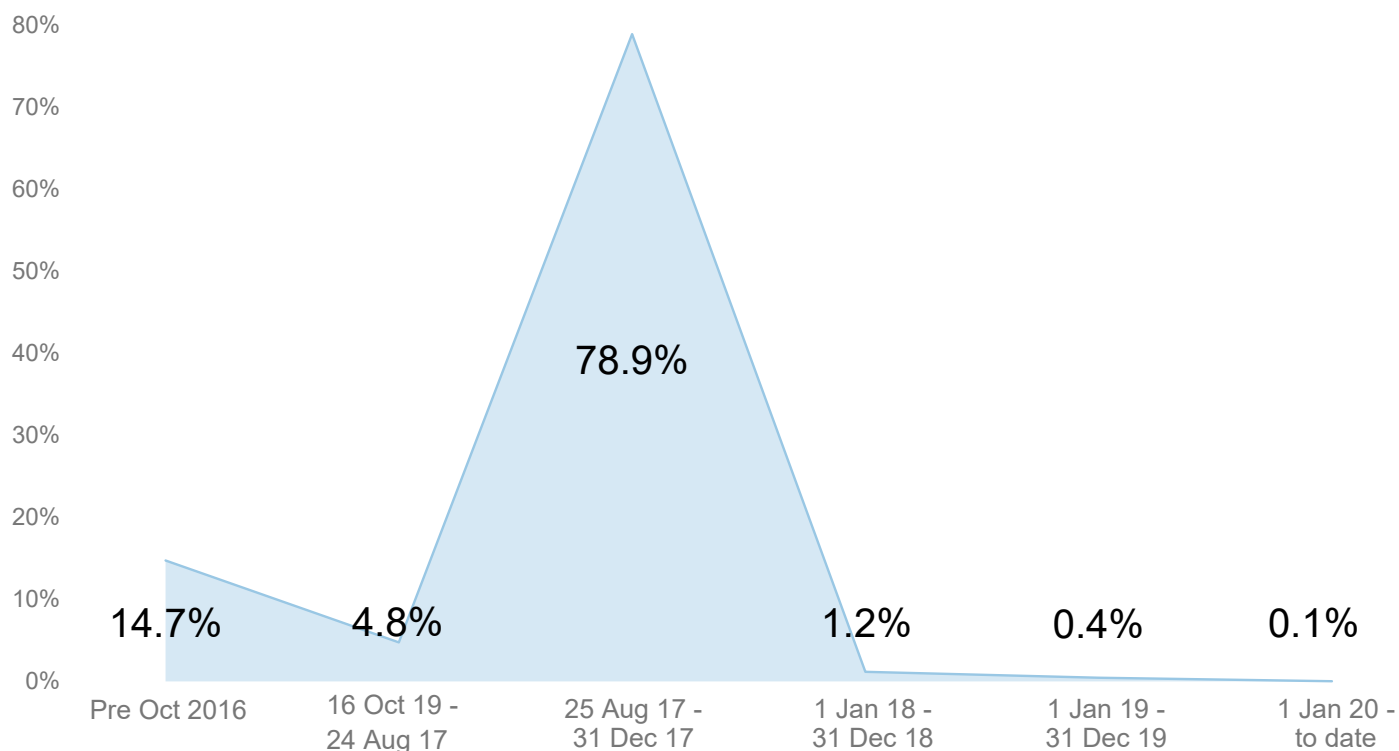

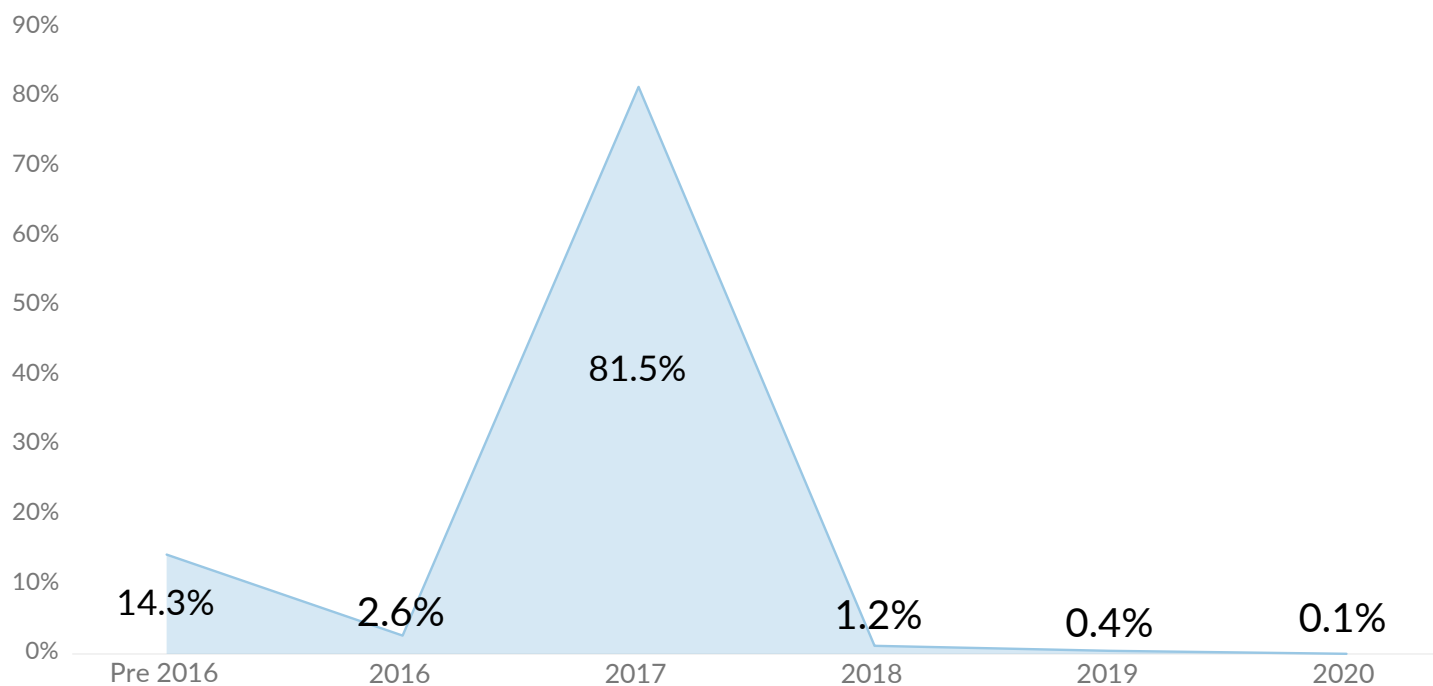
Families by period of arrival *
