

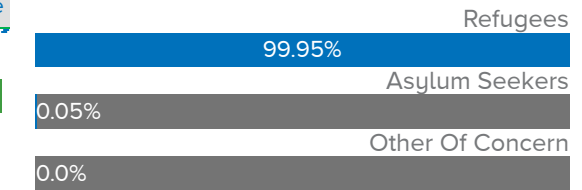

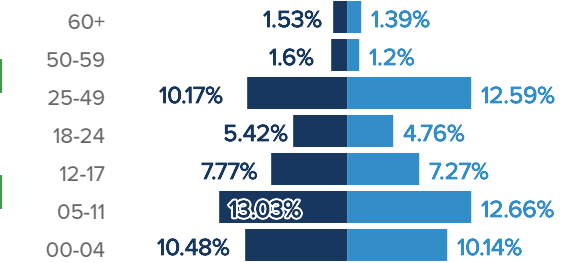

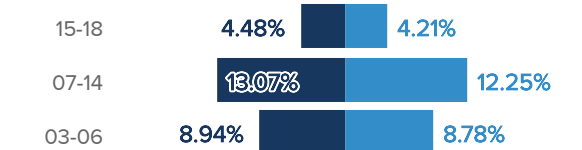
POPULATION BY STATUS
