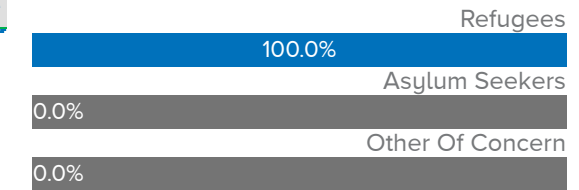

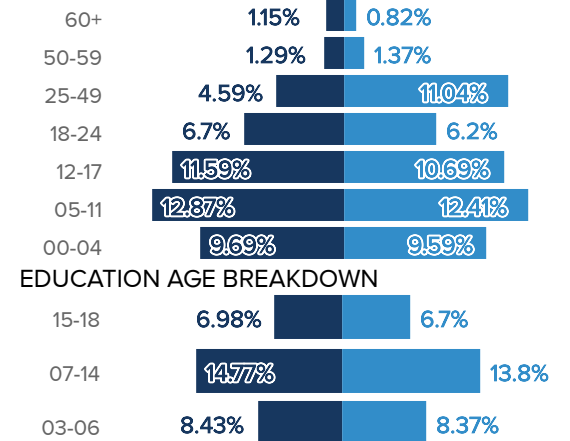

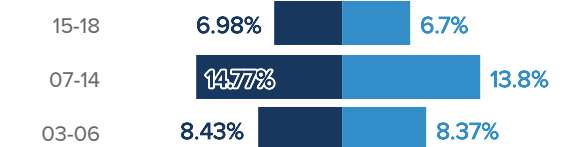
## POPULATION BY STATUS
