





Missing children in migration


 More than 18.000 migrant children estimated to have gone missing in Europe between 2018-2020 (Lost in Europe, data collected in 30 countries)





Missing children in migration

- 158 cases opened 360 ongoing from previous year
- In more than half of cases, the child was not found
- 66% of new cases are cross-border
- Average age 16
- 76.1% boys, 23.8% girls



Missing children in migration

- Few cases reported to police or hotline → underreporting
- Cases take the longest to be solved (not enough info, inefficient cross-border cooperation, low prioritization etc.)
- 62.5% of hotlines reported that covid-19 related measures had impact (closed borders, restriction of movement, limited access to support)




