<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Welcoming participants and discussing the agenda. - The CP-SWG started the year with our first in person event, having 42 individuals representing 35 different UN agencies, INGOs, NGOs, committees, and government. - The CP-SWG will alternate between Arabic and English every month, to allow for more engagement with national counterparts and stakeholders. - The structure of the meeting now includes a dedicated section any member who wishes to present their work to the working group. - The CP-SWG engaged in the Gap Analysis exercise; where 6 facilitators from various local and international partners led the group in a series of discussions and reflections on the most pressing topics and areas directly engages with or cross references child protection.
