"A 1% increase in the area affected by drought can slow a country's gross domestic product (GDP) growth by 2.7% per year"


EU, Science for environment policy

Over 34 percent of crop and livestock production loss in LDCs and LMICs is traced to drought, costing the sector \$37 billion overall. Drought impacts agriculture almost exclusively. The sector sustains 82 percent of all drought impact, compared to 18 percent in all other sectors.


