Reason behind the Re_Generations

Once unaccompanied children turn 18, they **no longer are eligible for several protection benefits and services.** Losing the right of having a representative or a legal guardian they immediately experience an **abrupt loss of guidance** which affect dramatically the migrant child's regular stay in the country (e.g. his/her appropriate accommodation, his/her access to medical and psychosocial assistance, his/her continuation of education or vocational training, and access in the labor market).



Act as a bridge

Mentoring supports beneficiaries beyond reaching "typical" adulthood. The mentorship relationship embodies the first months after the mentee turns 18, and/or their possible future relationship after the end of the mentoring contract.
