

### Key figures and narrative analysis






Uganda continues to receive new arrivals from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and South Sudan, through the Southwestern and Northern borders.

The situation remains calm at Bunagana border but also unpredictable. In the reporting period, a total of 830 individuals were relocated to Nakivale refugee settlement and as a result, the population at the holding and transit centres is now 10,078 as of 16 June 2022.

During the reporting period, a total of 112 individuals were relocated to Rwamwanja refugee settlement from Bwera Holding Centre in Kasese district and now holds a population of 26 individuals .

Note that this dashboard is only showing figures for new arrivals who have undergone Level 1 registration, it therefore does not include those who are staying along the border or with host community.


