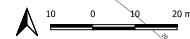

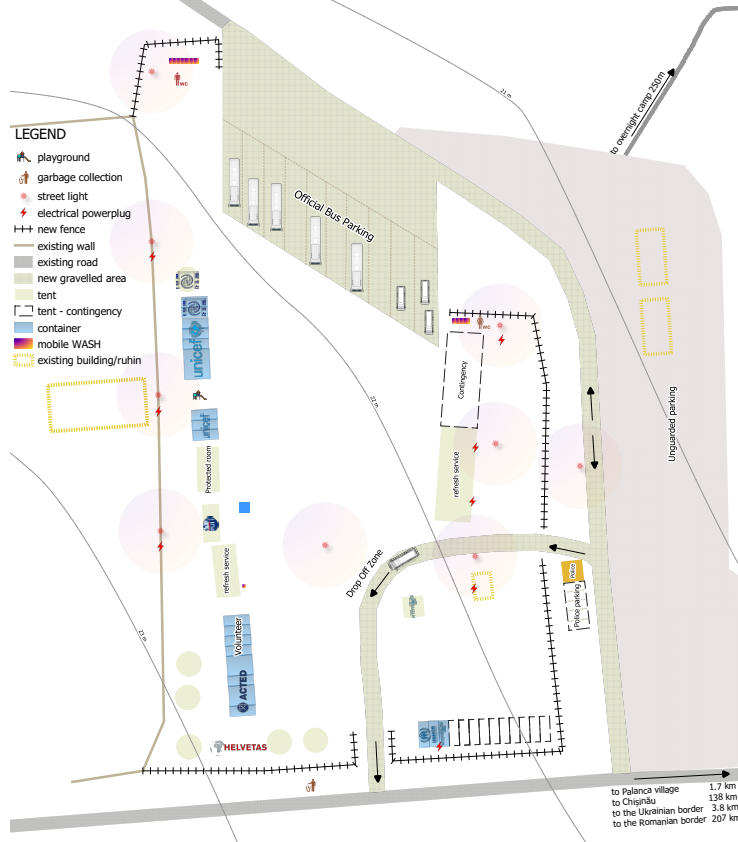

- **Government consolidation is ongoing**

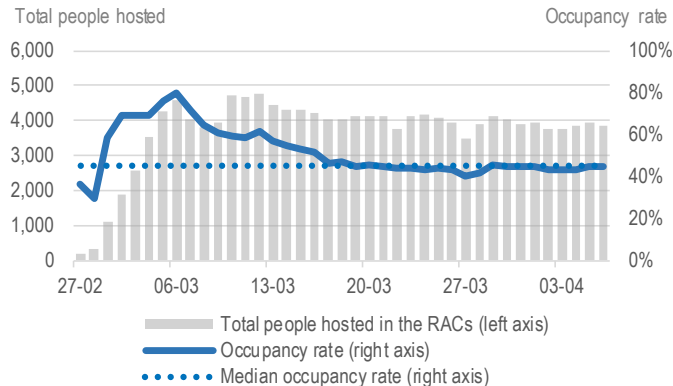
- Number of RACs: 95

People hosted in RACs since receiving approval to open



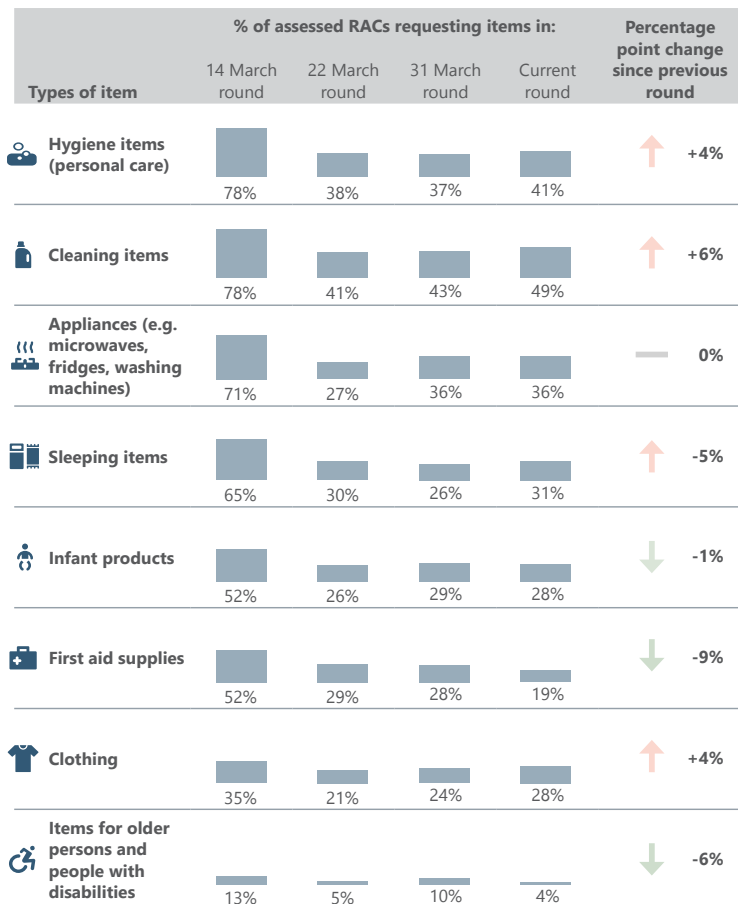

Strategic Priorities

	Transit	Short-stay 24-72 hours	Medium stay weeks to 2 months	Long stay > 2 months

Contingency Plan

- Crisis centre has identified several potential transit and accommodation sites
 - Assessment priorities: transport access, infrastructure, NFI, WASH, protection, access to services
 - Capacity needed for possible urgent works and supplies
- Prepositioning and coordination of supplies and distributions
 - Probable gaps: WASH, some NFI (don't jump, wait for assessment!)
- Transport: need to identify more standby capacity
