<b>World Refugee Day</b>	<p>The Moldova Inter-Agency Coordination Team informs about the events prepared by UNHCR in the frame of World Refugee Day 2022, which is today June 20<sup>th</sup>. The global theme this year will focus on the right to safety and highlight the fact that Every person has the right to seek safety – whoever they are, wherever they come from, and whenever they are forced to flee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Today on June 20th, there are 2 events: The inauguration of the Moldova for Peace Community Center and an event by CCR with Exhibition of drawings, paintings and handicrafts made by refugee children.</li> <li>• The main event will be on <b>21 June 2022 at the National History Museum at 17,30</b>, a joint event with the government of Moldova. All partners are invited to join this event. Invitations were sent last week.</li> <li>• There will also be a local celebration at Palanca (agenda is being developed), and a celebration took place in Balti on June 19<sup>th</sup> organized by the participants of the Local Coordination Forum.</li> </ul> <p>The celebration of this day is also a moment to underline the importance of the cooperation amongst all the actors involved, so we expect to see all partners in the events.</p>	



<p><b>Disability inclusion checklist - Disability Task Force</b></p>	<p>Ludmila Malcoci from Key stone Moldova on behalf of the Disability Task Force (under the Protection Working Group) presented the first draft of the Disability Inclusion checklist. The checklist is an effort to assess the mainstreaming of disability within the refugee response by all Working Groups and Sub Working Groups. It covers thematic areas related to all sectors.</p> <p>The checklist was developed with technical inputs from UNDP, IOM and in coordination with the Inclusion &amp; livelihoods WG. <p><b>PSEA updates/PSEA funds</b></p>	<p>Kristin Schmitz, PSEA Coordinator informed that UNHCR together with the PSEA Network facilitated a high-level mission from June 14th-15th in Moldova. The visitors were Jane Holl Lute: Special Coordinator on Improving UN Response to Sexual Exploitation and Abuse, Diane Goodman: UNHCR’s Senior Coordinator on PSEA and Sexual Harassment, Wendy Cue: Senior Coordinator on Protection from SEA from OCHA, Eric Cottenoir: Senior Political Affairs Officer from OSCSEA, and Sofian Mossallam: Special Assistant/Political Affairs Officer from OSCSEA. The aim of the visit was to better understand SEA risks faced by refugees from Ukraine in Moldova and operational challenges. Mission activities included a delegation and UN rep visit to Moldexpo cash, protection desk, blue dot, airlift, orange space, and other service sites; a joint PSEA Network and GBV and CP SWG presentation and dialogue comprised of UN agencies, INGOs, and 9 local organizations; and a meeting and dialogue with UNCT and UN agency reps.</p> <p>The network established multiple SEA CFMs including a dedicated hotline, email, and online SEA self-report form. Through partner engagement and community consultations, these CFMs will be tested and adapted. These mechanisms are posted in informative posters that are being distributed across the country. Also, the network is planning to conduct Community consultations to get their view on the best complaint mechanism and adjust.</p> <p><b>ICVA PSEA Funds:</b> The fund consists of small rapid grants for local and national NGOs to create their own outreach communication on PSEA. <p>GBV Safety Audit, GBV Sub Working Group,</p>	<p>Fatima Alwahaidy, UNFPA GBV Specialist, presented in name of the GBV Sub Working Group the results of the Safety Audit carried out in the past weeks.
