Emergency in Ukraine – Immediate Relief Assistance

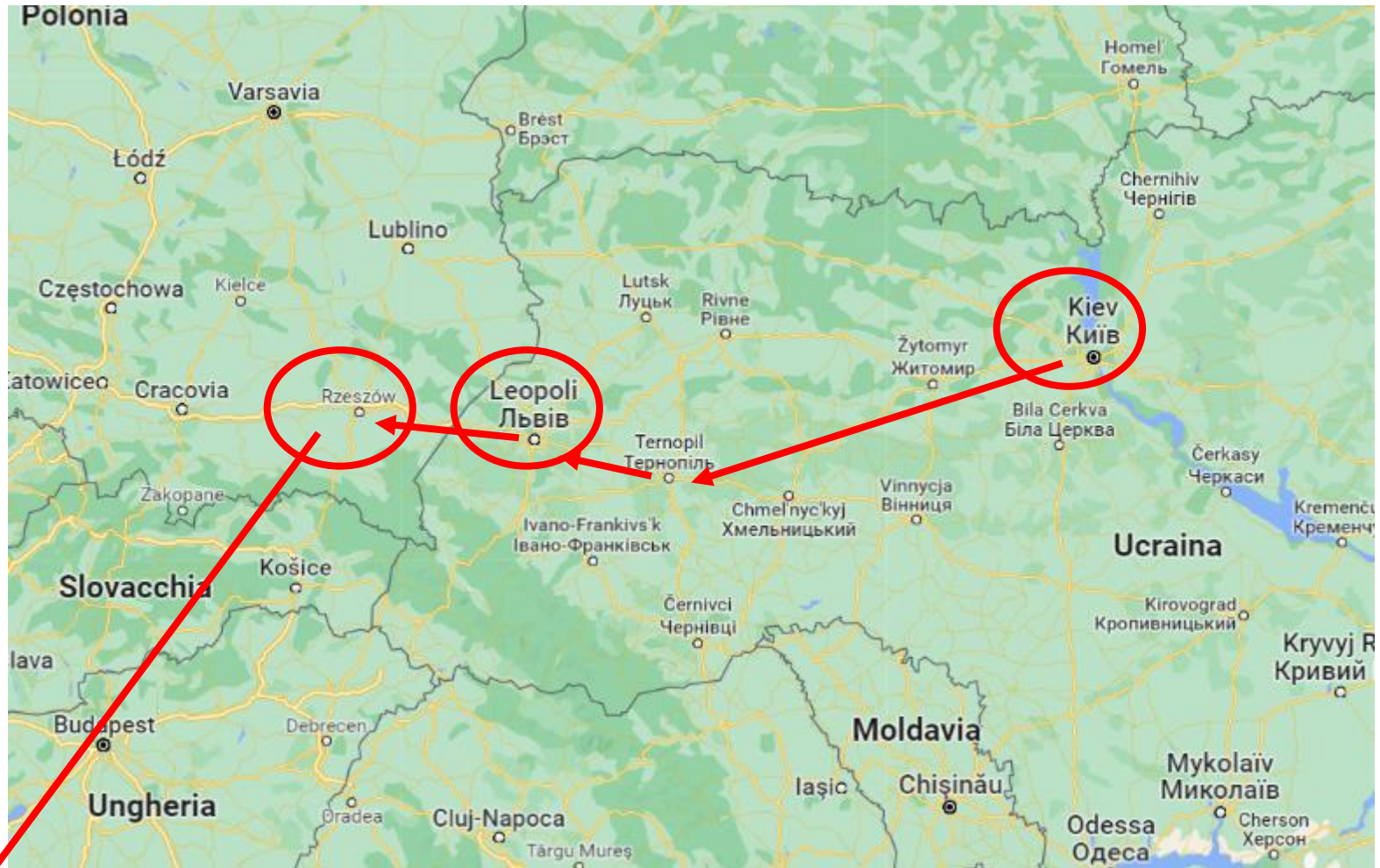




Soleterre is working in Ukraine since 2003, providing medical treatment, accommodation and psychological support to children with cancer and their families in Kiev and Lviv.

Since February 24th 2022 Kiev is under attack. There are many civilians on the run, the authorities advice those who are remaining to immediately find a safe shelter.

For children with cancer it was a tragic day: **surgical interventions were suspended, and also chemotherapy sessions had to be re-scheduled. The priority now is to provide a safe shelter for children and their families, and ensure the continuity in medical treatment for cancer in Ukraine or abroad.**



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Ongoing actions:

- 1. Provision of special medicines for oncological children and war injured patients addressed to hospitals (Ukraine)**
- 2. Structural and rehabilitation support for Children's Hospitals (Ukraine)**
- 3. Psychological support and psychiatric referral for refugees (Ukraine and Poland)**
- 4. Psychological supervisions for medical and NGOs' staff (Poland)**
- 5. Psychological support for Ukrainian oncological pediatric patients in Rzeszow (Poland)**

Psychological support for Ukrainian oncological pediatric patients in Rzeszow (Poland)

Main issues identified :

- ❖ Feelings of discrimination by Polish pediatric patients' families;
- ❖ Lack of economical support for oncological treatments (both for Ukrainian refugees and Polish patients);
- ❖ Lack of proper accomodations for Ukrainian oncological pediatric patients;
- ❖ Access to education for Ukrainian children unable to attend schools for health reasons.
