


VERIFIED IDP SITES IN XUDUR AS OF JULY 2022




Map of verified IDP sites in Xudur - July 2022

Assessment overview

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Xudur in July 2022 led by the SWSCRI. 16 IDP sites were identified hosting 4,976 households or 16,385 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in October 2021, there was a decrease of 2 IDP site, 2,239 Households or 18,765 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were

120 (61% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

137 (50% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

52 (37% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

176 (52% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

46 (54% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

53 (55% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

584 (3.6%)

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

19% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (6%) and high (13%) risk of eviction

56% of sites have landowner authorized occupancy type of land tenure

75% of sites have no agreement in place

100% of those that have agreements have oral agreements

100% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates

6% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

1 IDP sites (6%) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods requently)
