













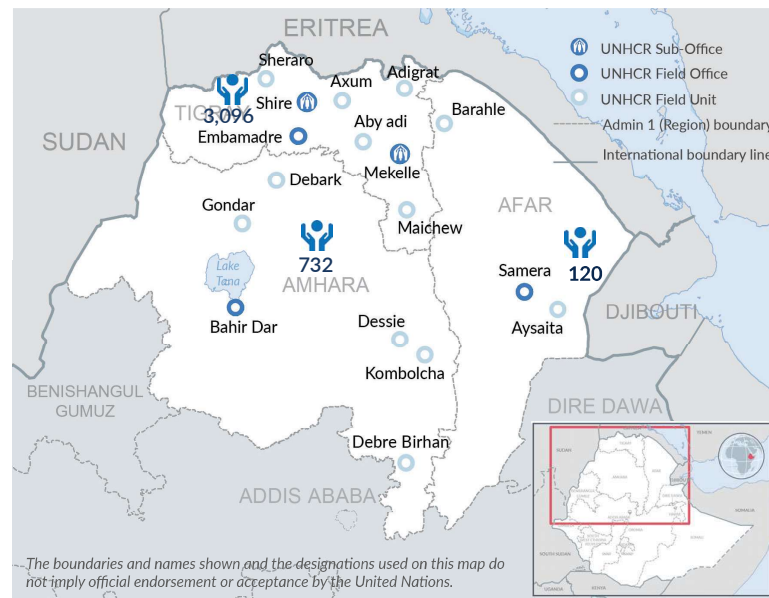


ACHIEVEMENTS

-  **1,660,338** Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) benefitted from UNHCR protection interventions in Northern Ethiopia
-  **834,562** IDPs with host community reached by assessments
-  **347,075** IDPs received Core Relief Items
-  **34,628** IDP voluntary returns supported with regional authorities and partners in Amhara and Tigray
-  **29,987** Women and girls received dignity kits
-  **34,373** IDPs benefitted from UNHCR emergency shelter kits
-  **37,907** IDPs relocated to selected IDP sites
-  **9,238** IDP and Children/youths provided with MHPSS at Protection Desks and CFSs
-  **359,000** IDPs in 65 CCCM-managed sites
-  **58,249** IDPs reached with awareness raising sessions on General Protection, GBV Prevention and Response
-  **3,921** IDPs assisted by 51 Protection Desks with counselling and referral to adequate services
