Action Points:

- **Donors Introduction**
 - Representatives of the UK and USA introduced themselves to CWG and urged a pragmatic approach, focus on efforts to de-duplicate, and ensuring updated RRP information for Romania was made available publically.

 - **Update & discussion on the meeting with Ms. Turza (support to host community & 6-month cash)**
 - RAIS platform was almost ready and the revised data sharing agreement would be circulated. In the meantime CWG members should inform beneficiaries that they should not receive assistance from more than one cash actor.
 - The Government is expecting a tentative timeline of 6 months from the adoption of the National Action Plan (NAP) until the full inclusion of Ukrainians under the national social protection programme.
 - Partners could consider extending recurrent MPC as per the vulnerability criteria for those with a minimum 7 days stay in the country:
 - up to 3 months for non-temporary Protection Holders, and
 - up to 6 months for Temporary Protection Holders

Action: CWG members to review/consider this to further discuss in the next CWG meeting.

 - The Government stressed the requirement of a minimum 7-day stay in the country before enrollment for recurrent MPC for all cash organizations.
- Action: CWG members to include a minimum 7-day stay criteria in their program if it is not included already.
- The Government requested a risk analysis to explain how partners were mitigating risks.
- Action: UNHCR would clarify what format and if a consolidated analysis was sufficient (note after the meeting from UNHCR: the Government agreed to have two consolidated risk analyses per each modality of (1) in-person registration and (2) virtual registration)

- **AOB (CWG Dashboard, 5W, meeting modality, etc.)**
 - Partners were requested to fill in the CWG 5W, and not the Inter-sector 5W as the data will be extracted from CWG 5W by UNHCR IM
 - CWG meetings would be blended - in-person and online modalities (Romanian Red Cross would host the next meeting at their office)
