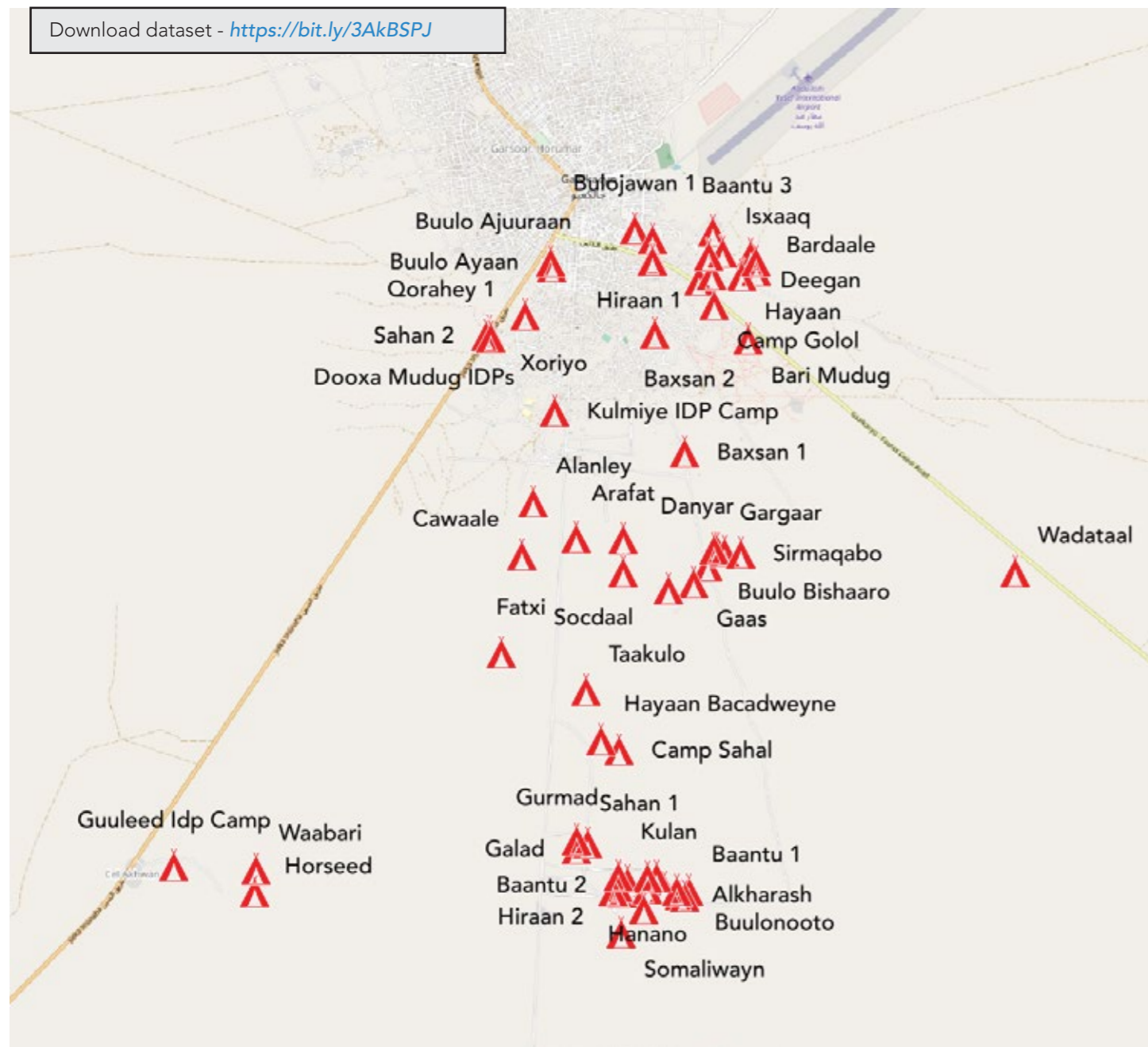

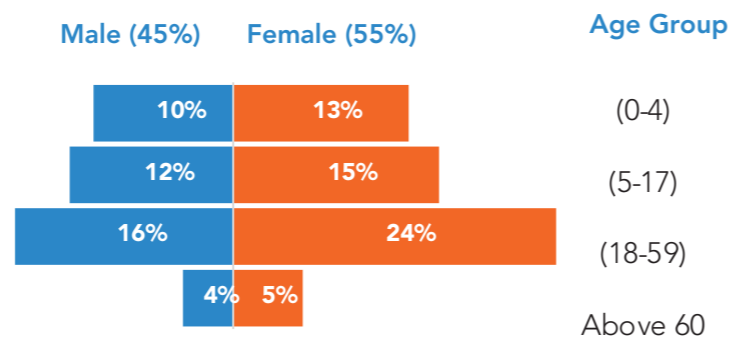
Map of verified IDP sites in South Gaalkayo - August 2022

### Assessment overview

A joint IDP site verification exercise was conducted in South Gaalkayo in August 2022. The operation was led by CARE, CPD, Danyar Relief, DEH, DRC, DRRDO, GECPD, IMC, IRC, KAF, MercyCorps, NoFYL, NRC, SAF-UK, SVDG, TUOS and WISE. 74 IDP sites were identified hosting 15,309 households or 89,788 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in January 2022, there was a decrease of 1,137 Households or 7,129 individuals. There has been an increase of 13 IDP sites.

## People living with health difficulties

Using the Washington Group Disability Questions, statistics of people living with health difficulties were derived

**2,644 (2.9%)**  
people living with health difficulties

- 500 (55% Female)** have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)
- 405 (52% Female)** have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)
- 421 (46% Female)** have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding
- 604 (49% Female)** have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs
- 506 (80% Female)** have difficulty with dressing and/or washing
- 208 (48% Female)** have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

## Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

**30%** of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme and high risk of eviction

- 38%** of sites have landowner authorized occupancy
- 54%** of sites have agreement in place
- 55%** of those that have agreements have written agreements
- 65%** of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates
- 30%** of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

## Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

**10** IDP sites (13%) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
