

## WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, 286,700 people are displaced - an increase of 3,000 from last week.

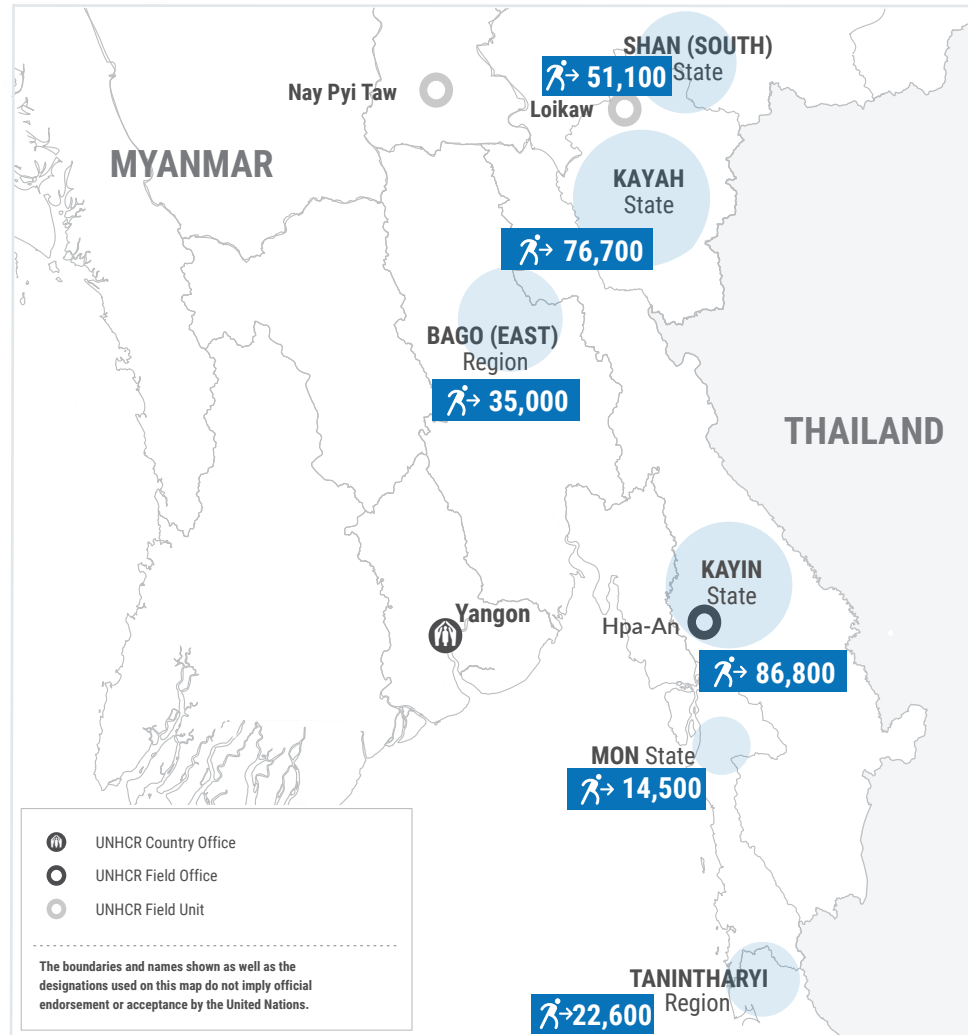
Ongoing clashes and shelling in Kyaukkyi Township, Bago (East) Region, forced 1,253 people to flee from their villages on 27 August.

UNHCR and partners were able to verify 651 IDPs in Palaw town, displaced during clashes that reportedly occurred between the Tatmadaw and PDF in May and June 2022 in several villages in Palaw Township. Local media also reported displacements in Tanintharyi Region in early September - verification is still ongoing.

UNHCR partners have verified the presence of 2,385 IDPs who sought safety in the jungle near Loikaw town, Kayah State. They were displaced in January and February 2022 due to indiscriminate shelling, and have not been able to return to their places of origin. Some 275 IDPs displaced since March 2022 in Loikaw Township had to move a second time due to increased insecurity.

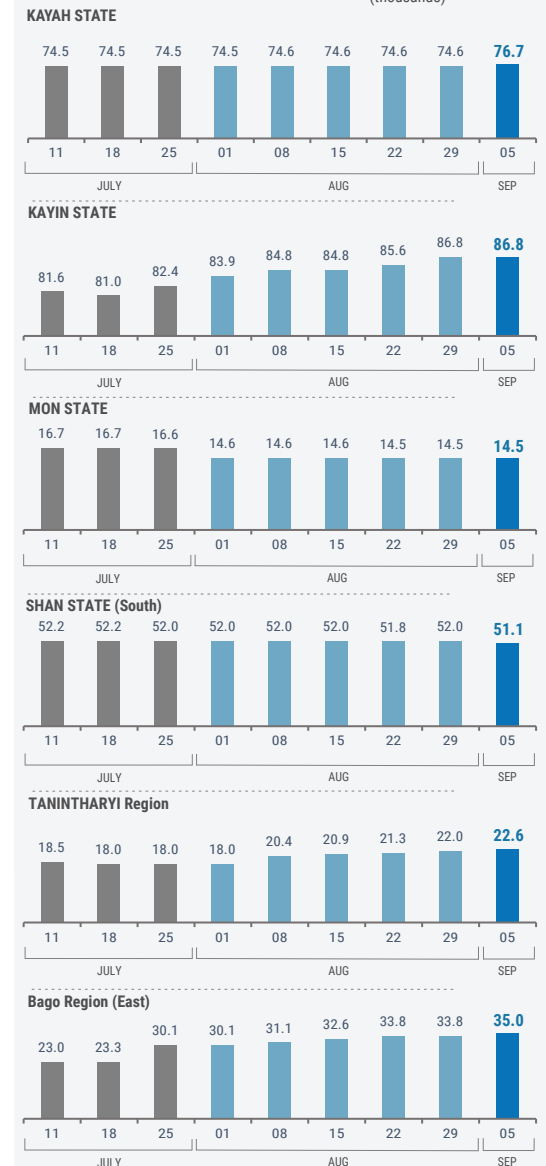
