


VERIFIED IDP SITES IN CABUDWAAQ AS OF DECEMBER 2022



Map of verified IDP sites in Cabudwaag - December 2022


Assessment overview

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Cabudwaaq in December 2022 by ADA, ADRO, ARD, CARE, DEH, GCRI, GECPD, HOD, NEPAD, NOFYL, OCHA, SCI, TUOS, UNHCR, and WEAIDAFRICAN.

31 IDP sites were identified hosting 16,913 households or 98,904 individuals. Compared to the previous site verification excercise in April 2022, there was an increase of 7 IDP Sites, of 2,849 households and 14,979 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were derived

6,246 (6.32%)

1449 (51% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

770 (48% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

↑↑↑ 754 (52% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

1840 (54% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

1 697 (53% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

136 (57% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

45% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (12.90%) and high (32.26%) risk of eviction

52% of sites have a Communal/Permanent ownership type of land tenure

19% of sites have agreement in place

17% of those that have agreements have written agreements

100% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates

13% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

0% of the sites has been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
