Introduction:

In response to the influx of Ethiopian refugees into eastern Sudan, UNHCR and the Government of Sudan, in collaboration with other partners, opened Babikre settlement in Gedaref State on 28 November 2021 to accommodate the refugees relocated from the transit centres at the border to this site. The majority of the refugees in Babikre settlement belong to Gemant ethnic group. As of end December 2022, the settlement accommodates 2,798 refugees, all of whom are biometrically registered and provided with assistance. The dashboard below presents the population profile for Babikre settlement.






Family Size




Age-Gender Breakdown




