| Updated figures and announcements (UNHCR) | <p>2023 RRP:</p> <p>Operational Plan:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sector Leads to quickly review the draft by today and look for red lines. • The draft will be shared with the region on Monday to be reviewed on 21-25 November 2022. • The draft will also be shared with the Government (DSU and Madam Turza’s office) to review. • Comments and finalization on 28 November to 5 December 2022. • Government’s working group names have changed. • DSU has requested to have a working session with the Sector Leads to discuss priorities on the week of 28 November 2022. • Inter-Agency Unit will add the name of the Government’s WG Leads to the Sector Leads Contact List. Government does not have a calendar for the individual WG meetings. | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The platform was introduced to 83 participants from 40 organizations through three sessions on 15-17 November 2022 to report quantitatively for 2022 and 2023. • Training will be continuous, capture the needs within your sector and training will be done. • Information Management (IM) colleague within the Inter-Agency Coordination Unit will do more follow ups on collecting data. • IM will share a manual on how to report on Activity Info. • IM will organize a dedicated training in one of the ISWG meetings for the Sector Leads on how to use the data. • IM will create different dashboards based on the data in the next two weeks. The first dashboard for each sector will be ready by the beginning of December 2022. • All Sector Leads are requested to reinforce within their sectors that Activity Info reporting is on the RRP and an inter-agency mechanism not UNHCR. Reporting in the RRP system will show what is happening on the ground. <p>Coordination structure:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A separate GBV sWG will be established to have a gender-based approach in all sectors • All WGs to include and connect better with CASH Technical and Livelihood WGs • Suggested to have a standalone Education WG. • IA to find out if Government is going to change its coordination structure. <p>Follow-up coordinator workshop:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IA will share the background folder by next week. • Sectors to share some good practices under the same folder. • Sector Leads to inform IA on how IA can support them |
