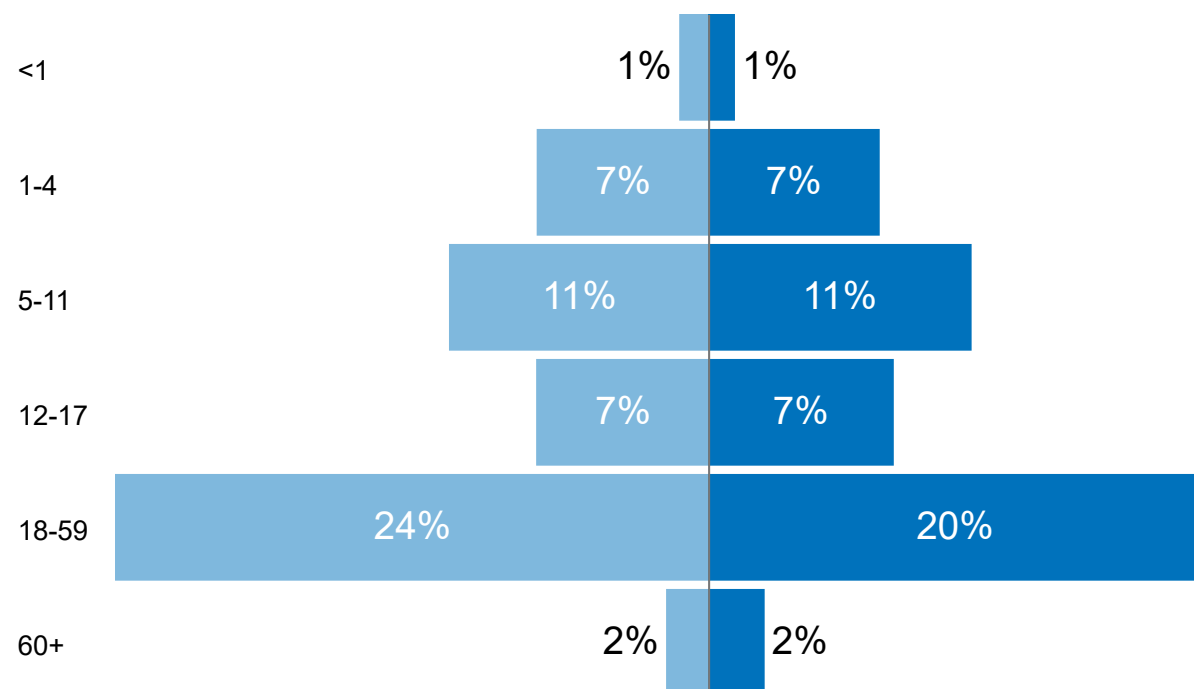

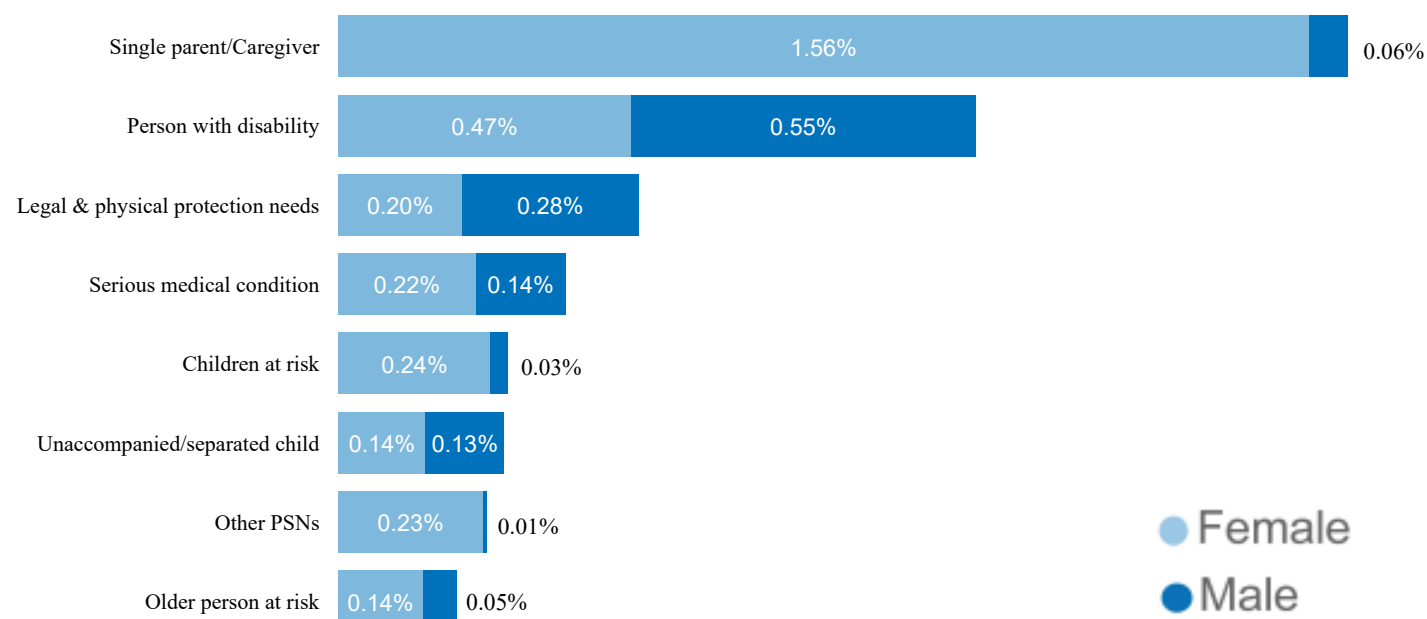

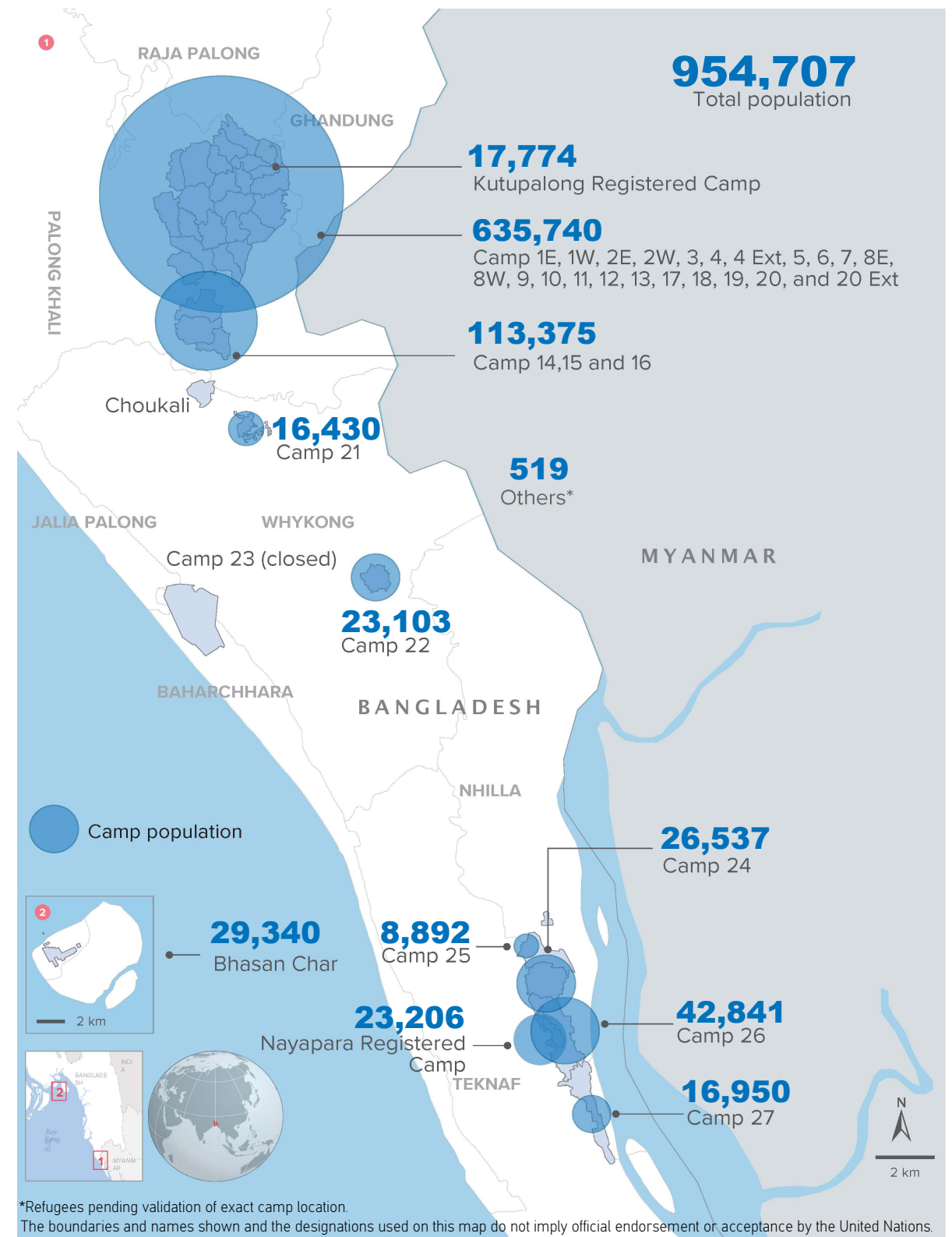


### Specific needs<sup>2</sup>

**3.95%** of total individuals have been identified with at least one specific need, **1%** being Persons with Disability

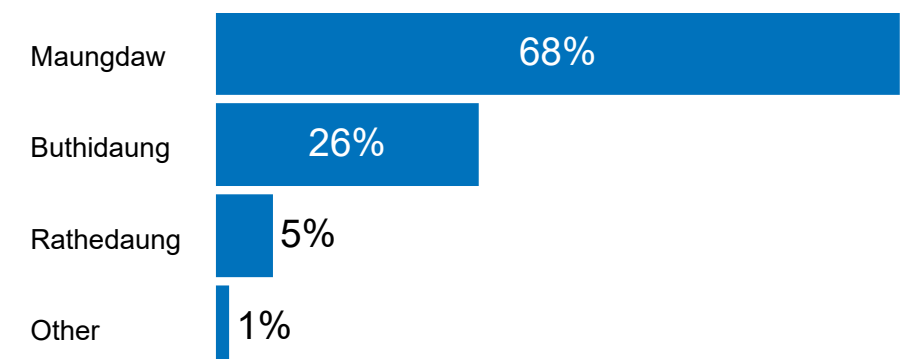


### Rohingya Population by Location



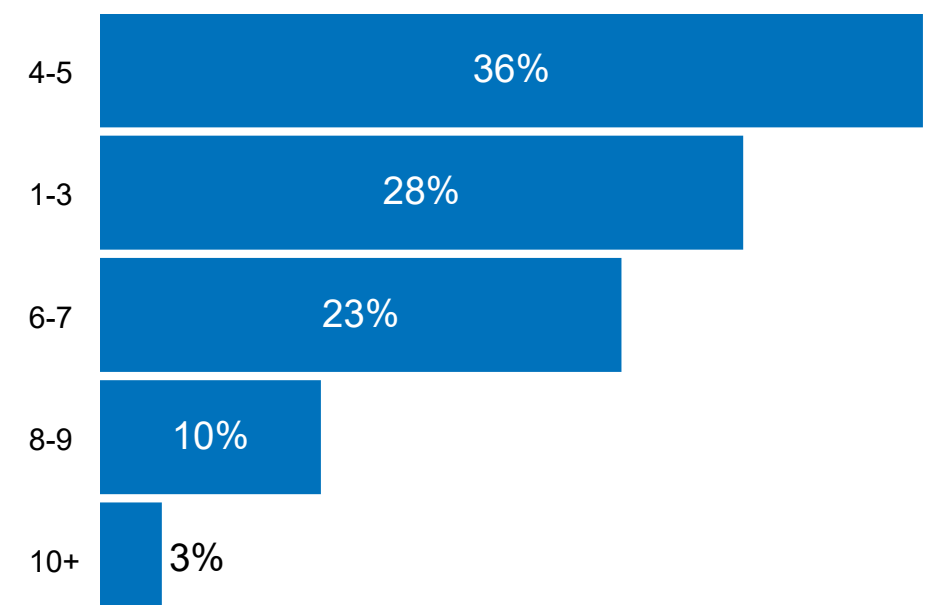
### Place of origin

**68%** of the rohingya came from Maungdaw township.

Note: A study carried out in 2021 by REACH/Helvetas ('Age and Disability Inclusion Needs Assessment, Rohingya Refugee Response, May 2021') estimated 12% of the population in the camps are living with disabilities. Government of Bangladesh-UNHCR registration activities are updating the disability data on continuous basis.
