

Task Force on disability report for 11.04-17.04

Keystone Moldova supported 48 families with a family member with a disability with the nutrition packages, assistive equipment, and medications through the Mobile team and the Hotline service. The Hotline counselors received 15 calls requesting various support. Six persons with disabilities were supported to access the cash support, 2 persons received psychological counseling, 3 persons with severe disabilities benefited of physical therapy, diagnostic services and medications. 4 persons were ensured with nutrition and hygienic products. The Mobile team mapped persons with disabilities in 10 shelters. They identified and assessed the needs of 14 adults with disabilities and 1 child with disabilities. The main needs of persons with disabilities are related to nutrition, medication, and assistive equipment. The child benefited of psychological counseling and was referred to Youth-friendly center to access additional services based on needs.

The NGO Fiecare Contribuie Pentru Schimbare supported 9 families with persons with disabilities: 5 families benefitted of psychological and behavioral support, 2 families of nutrition and hygienic packages, and 2 families with children with autism were included in needed service.

The NGO Motivatie supported 30 families hosting 140 refugees, including 20 babies, with nutrition and hygienic products. One adult with severe disabilities was ensured with adapted transportation.

SOS Autism is housing 18 families with persons with autism, delivering housing, nutrition, and medical services. 16 children with autism are supported with rehabilitation services.

NGO Centrul Pentru Drepturile Persoanelor cu Dizabilitati assessed the accessibility of the Center for older persons and person with disabilities from Chisinau and developed the assessment report. Based on the disposition of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection, 10% of the center places will be used for housing refugees with mobility disabilities.
