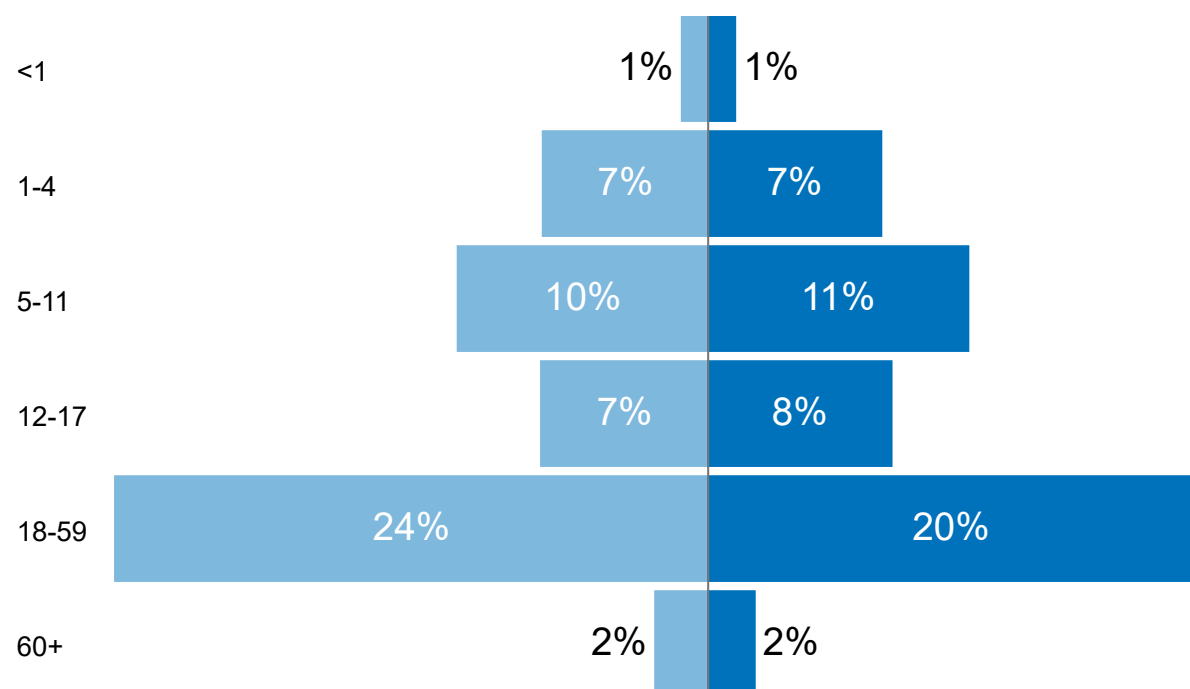

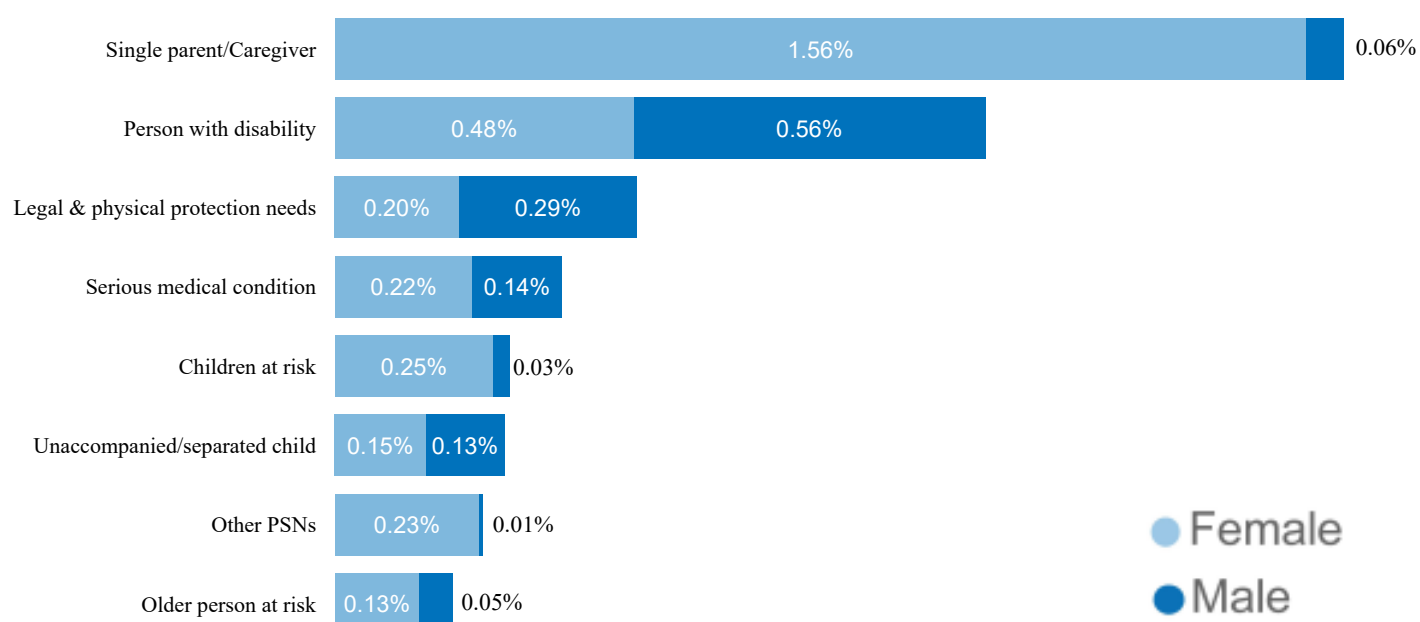

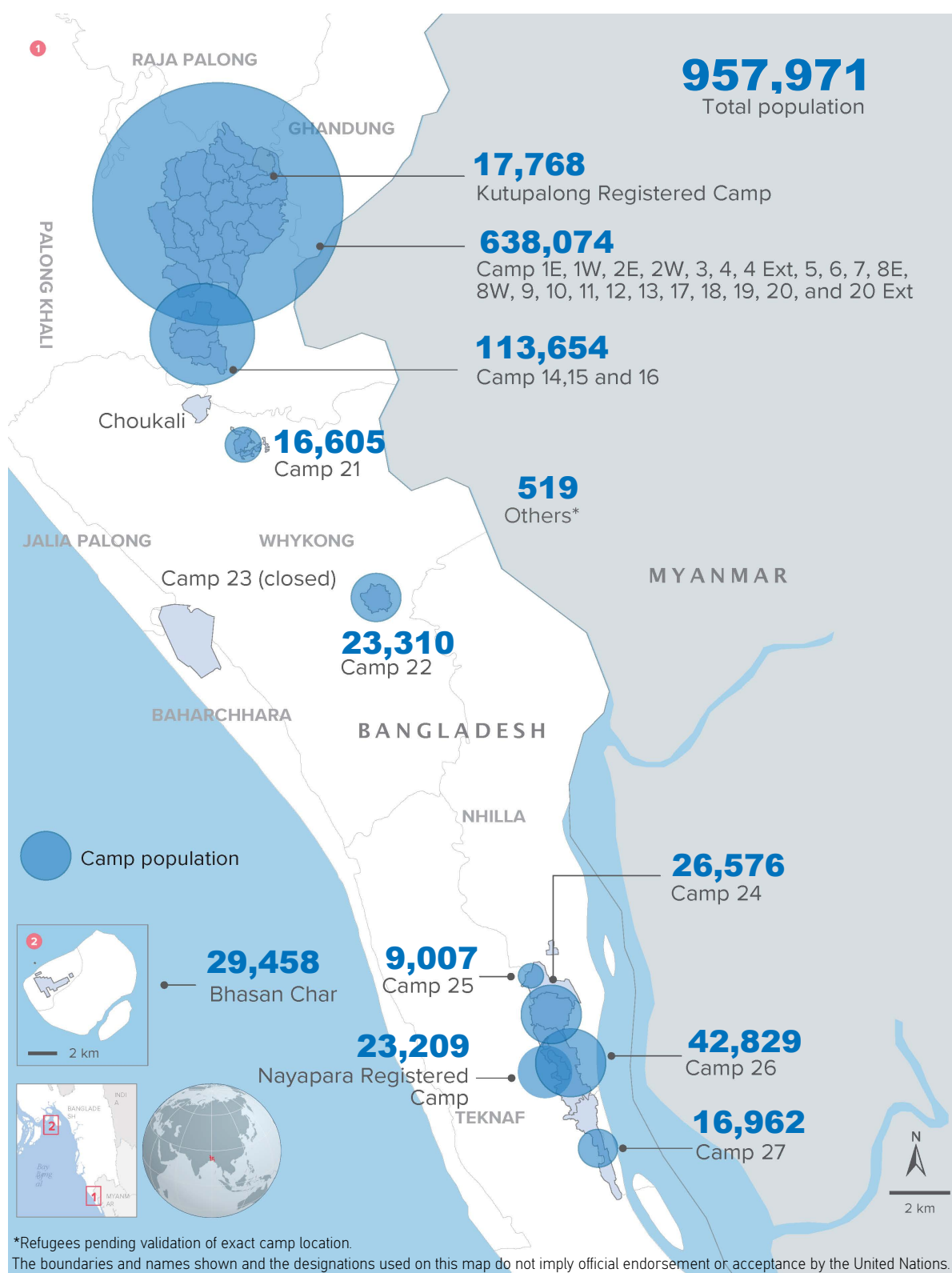


Specific needs ²

3.97% of total individuals have been identified with at least one specific need, **1%** being Persons with Disability

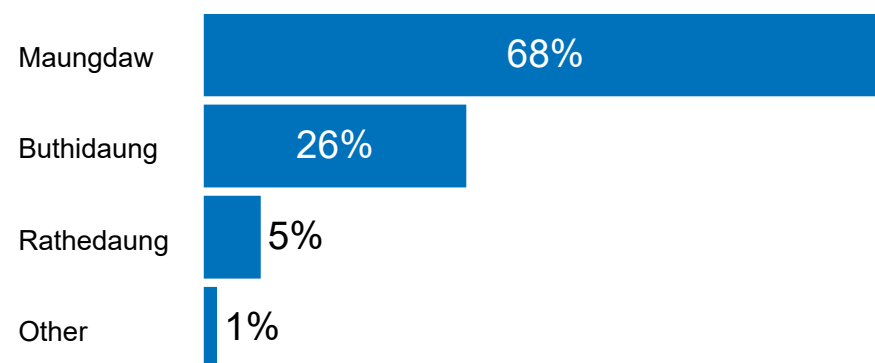


Rohingya Population by Location



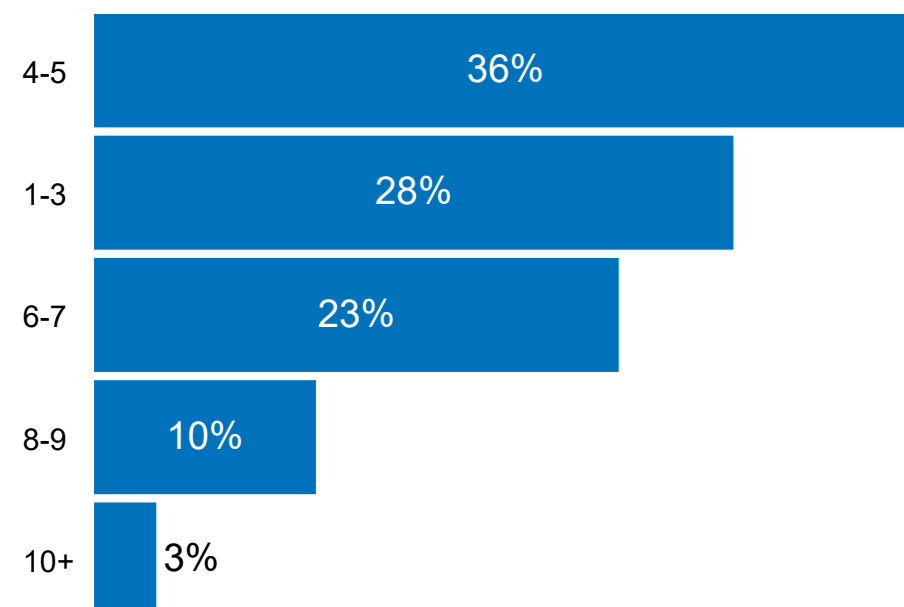
Place of origin
