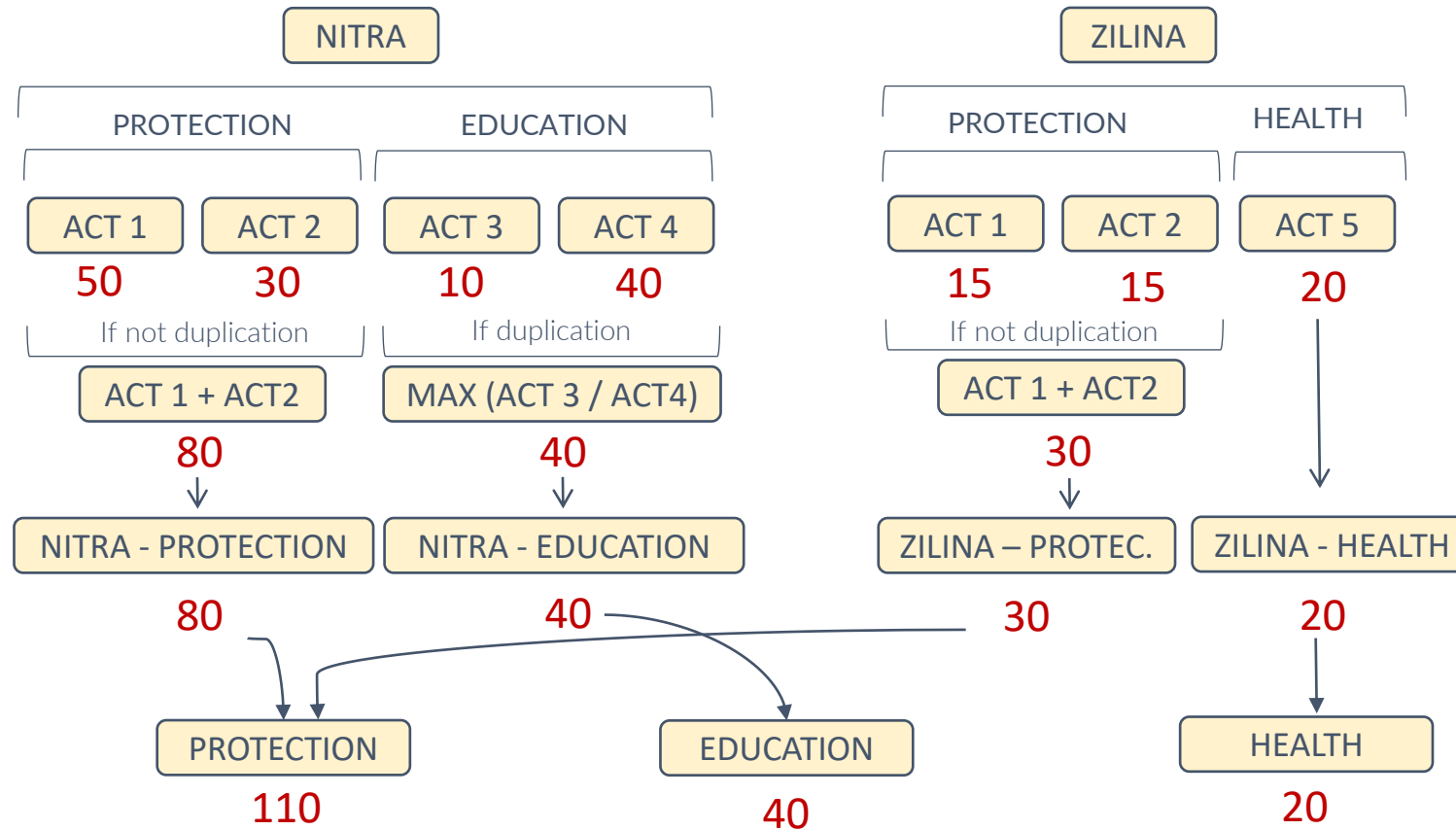

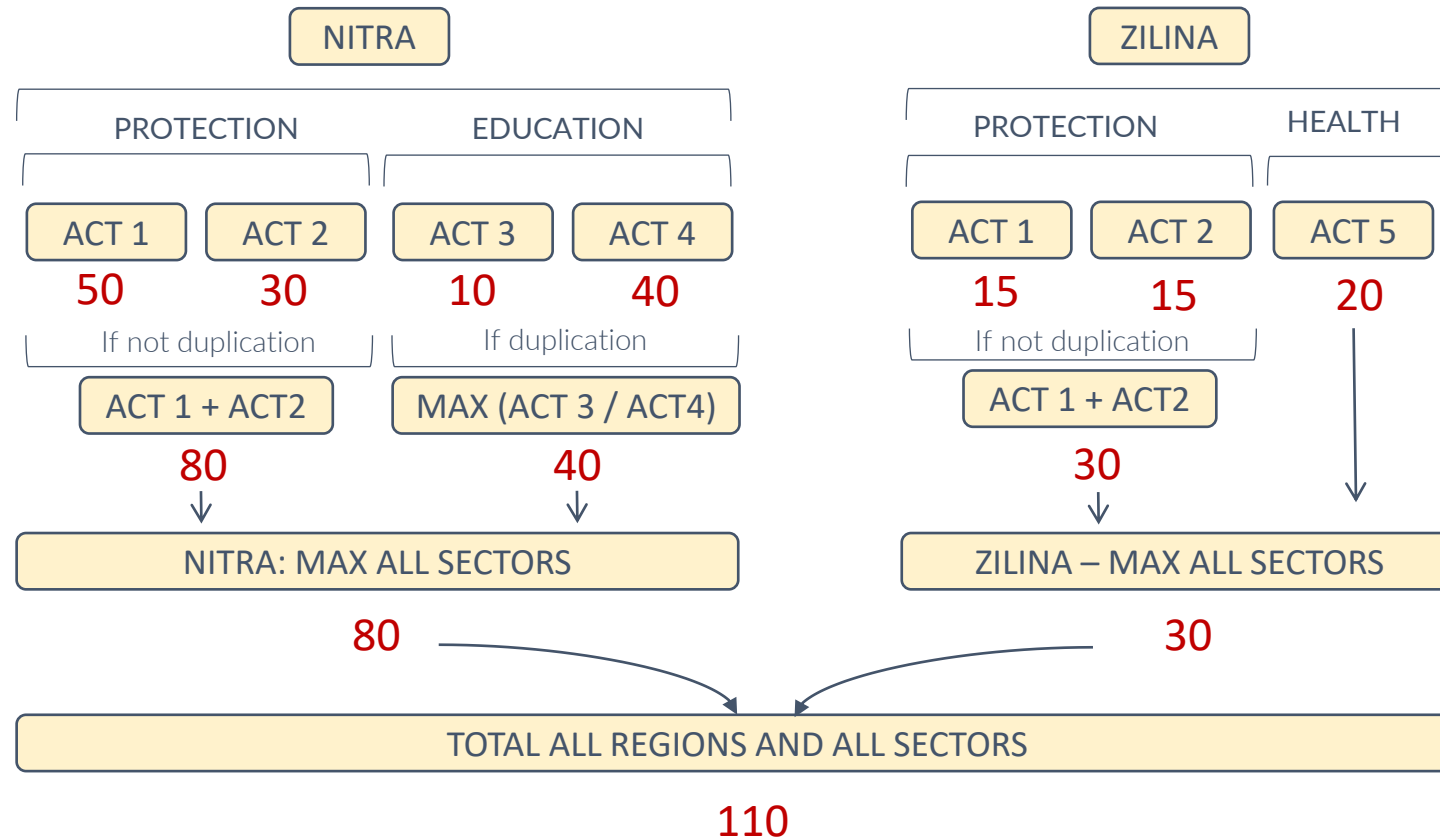

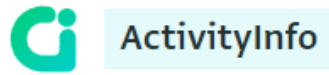




Received funds and gap by country
